## **RESULT OF ANALYSIS OF FEEDBACK FROM ALUMNAE**

**(2018-19)**

To connect our alumnae with their alma-mater the institution has a registered HMV Alumnae Welfare Association, the only of its kind in the city. Students who pass out from this great institution can remain in touch with us by becoming a member of this association. The special feature is that a number of scholarships are funded by our alumnae under the Udaan Scholarship Scheme. The annual alumnae meet is organized every year on the third Saturday of April.

HMV Alumnae Welfare Association (Regd.) aims to unite and strengthen HMV Alumnae ties among alumnae and Alma Mater. It is an active and impressive body with graduation and post-graduation registering both as life members and annual members. Till date, 112 alumnae have registered as life members of the Association.

The Association not only promotes and inspires a sense of belongingness among the old students for its Alma Mater but also collect Alumnae's suggestions and observations in the form of feedback for the development of the institution. Alumni questionnaires (Annexure) were filled from 1196 Graduates and 200 Post Graduates of the session 2018-19. The objective of the following report is to make an overall assessment of the college with regards to academic, infrastructure, placements, work culture, structural capability and the general environment of the college and make further improvements as per the suggestions given by its alumnae.

## Methodology

The feedback from alumnae on design and review of curriculum and other parameters was obtained through Structured Questionnaire which included several questions on various aspects of curriculum, environment and facilities provided.

A five point Likert scale has been used with weights assigned from 1 to 5 to different responses as follows:

- 1- Need Improvement
- 2- Average
- 3- Good
- 4- Very Good
- 5- Excellent

The Range of each order or level is determined by the following formula:

(Highest point in Likert Scale- Lowest point in Likert Scale)/ Number of Levels Used

Therefore      Range=  $(5-1)/5=4/5=0.8$

Hence

Range for 'Need Improvement' is	1.0 to 1.8
Range for 'Average' is	1.8 to 2.6
Range for 'Good' is	2.6 to 3.4
Range for 'Very Good' is	3.4 to 4.2
Range for 'Excellent' is	4.2 to 5.0

Data was collected with the help of sampling technique. The important observations emerged as under:-

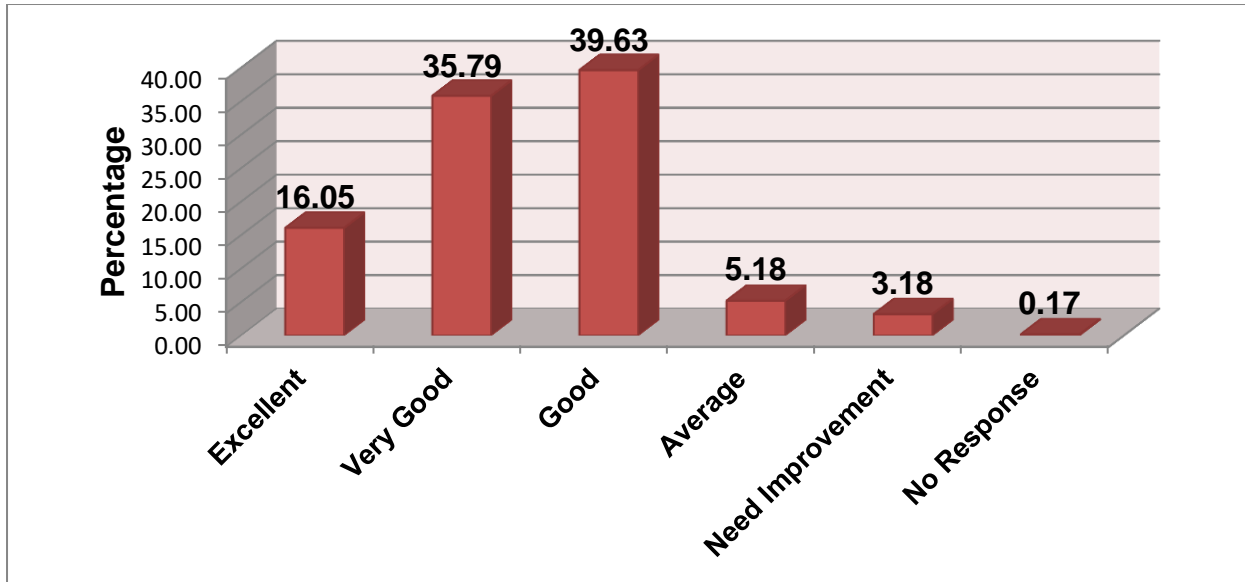

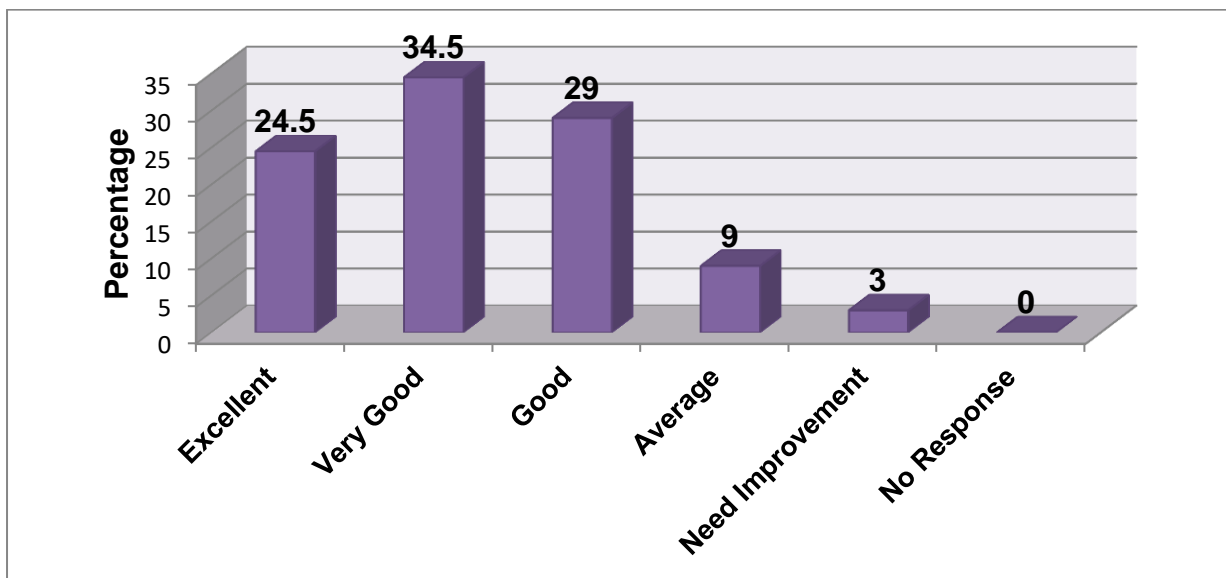

**Figure 1.1(b):-Admission Procedure (Post Graduates)**

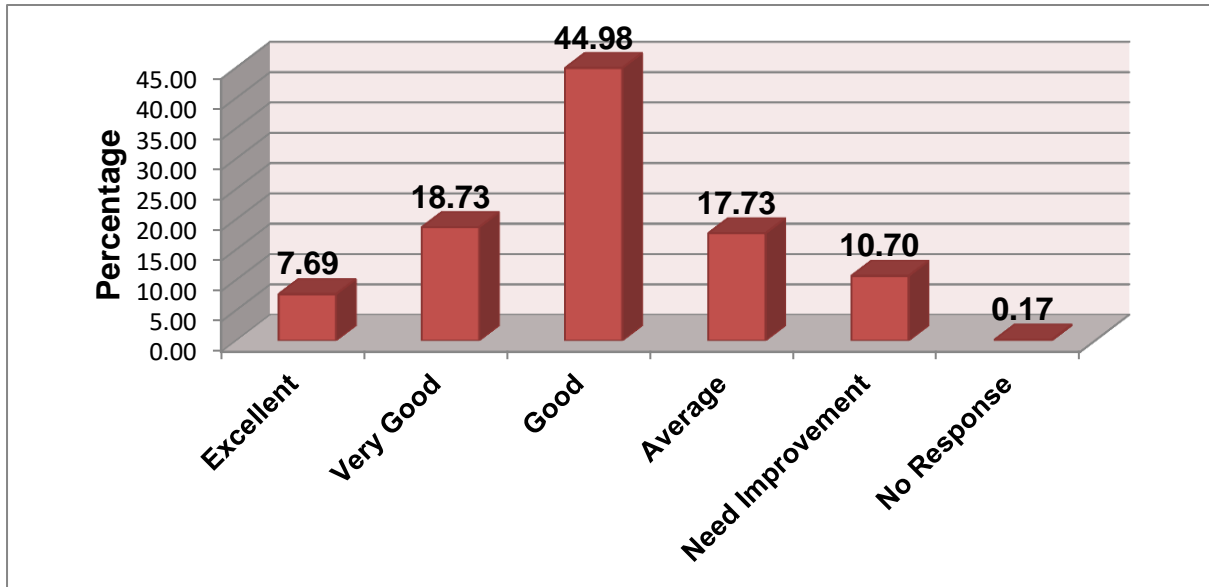
Regarding admission procedure, 91.47% of graduate alumnae and 88% of post graduate alumnae have expressed that the admission procedure of the college is excellent, very good and good. 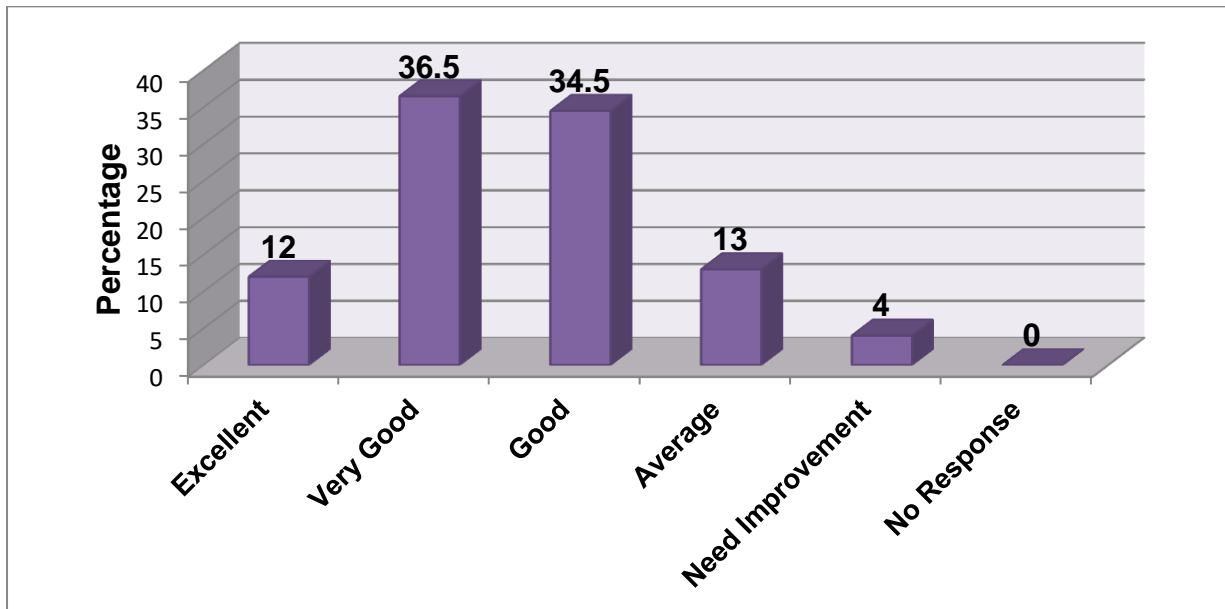

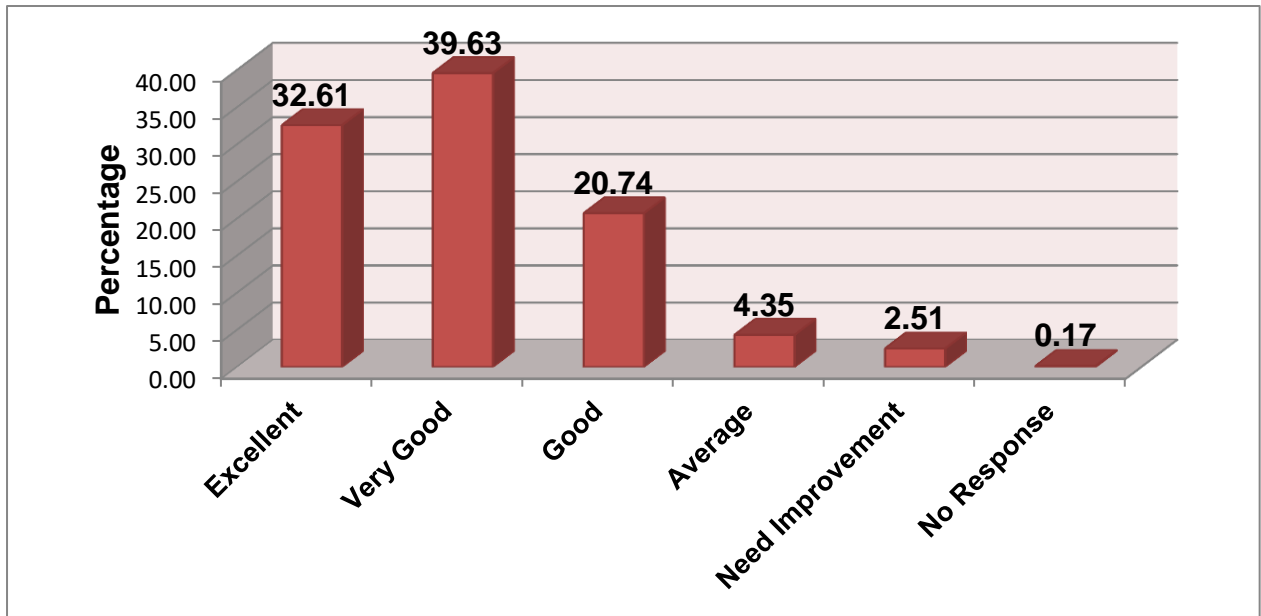

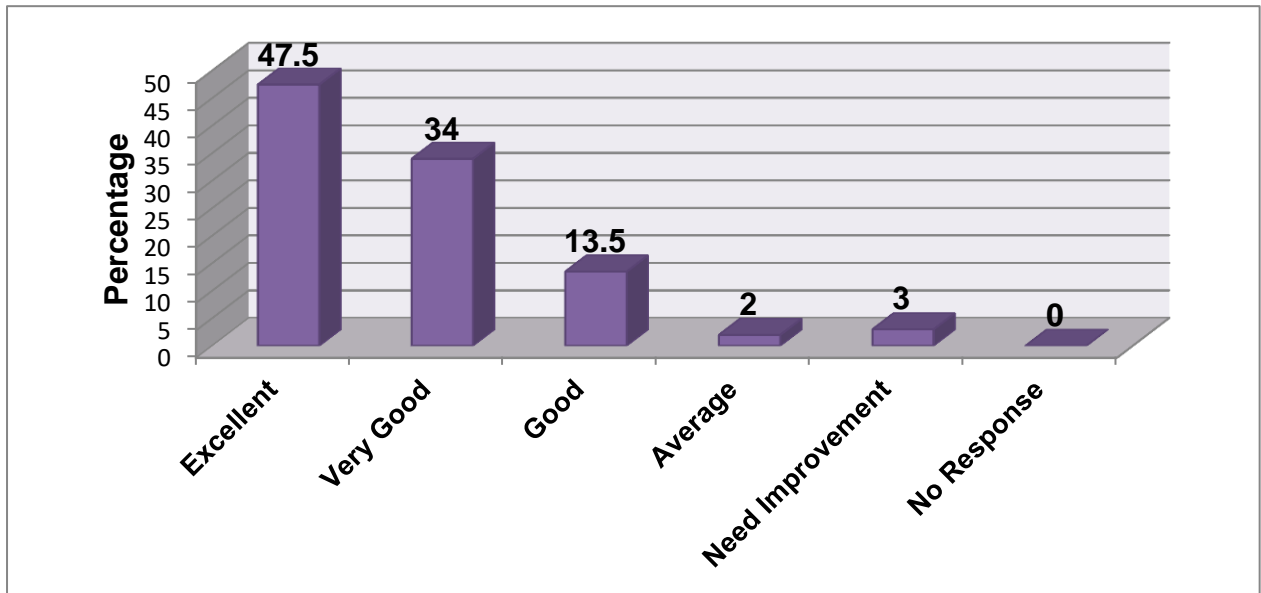

**Figure 1.3(b):-Campus Environment (Post Graduates)**

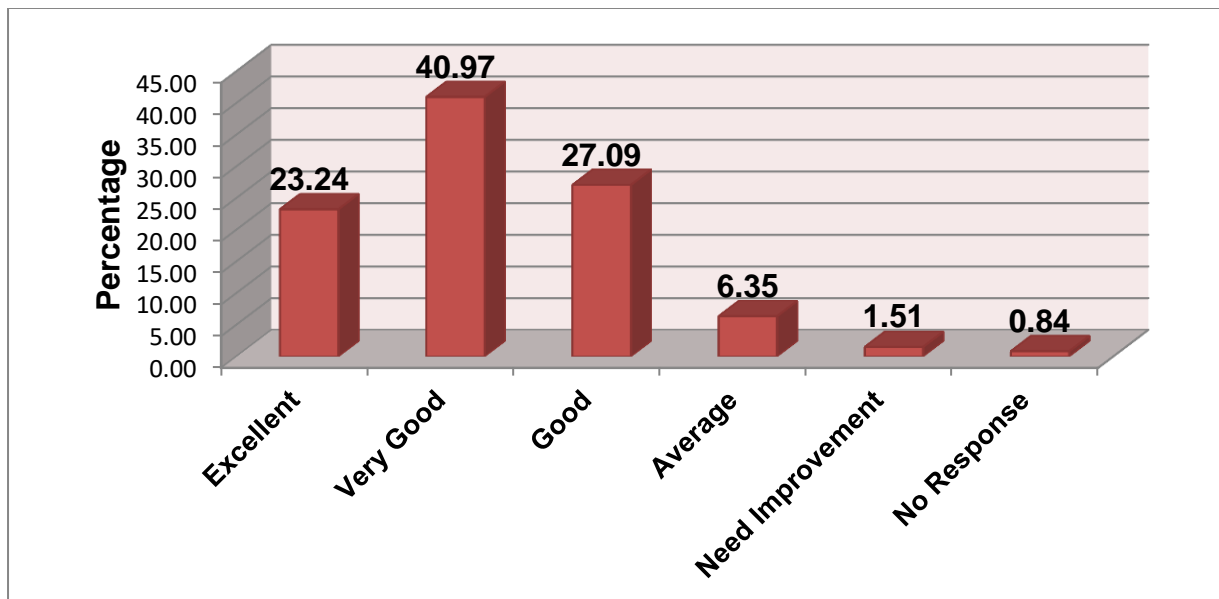

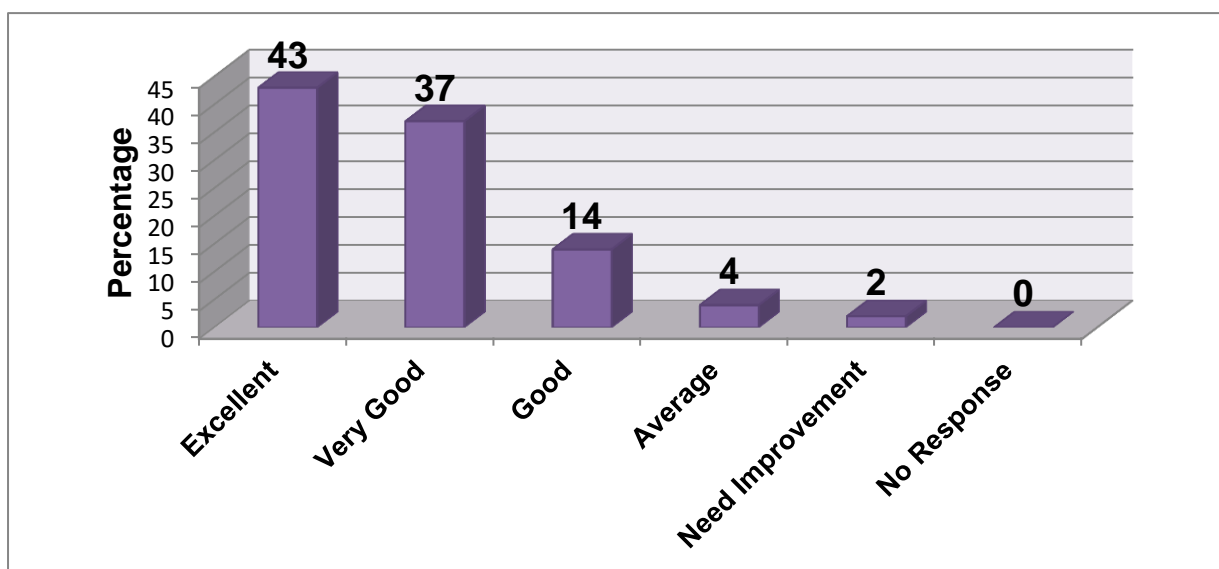

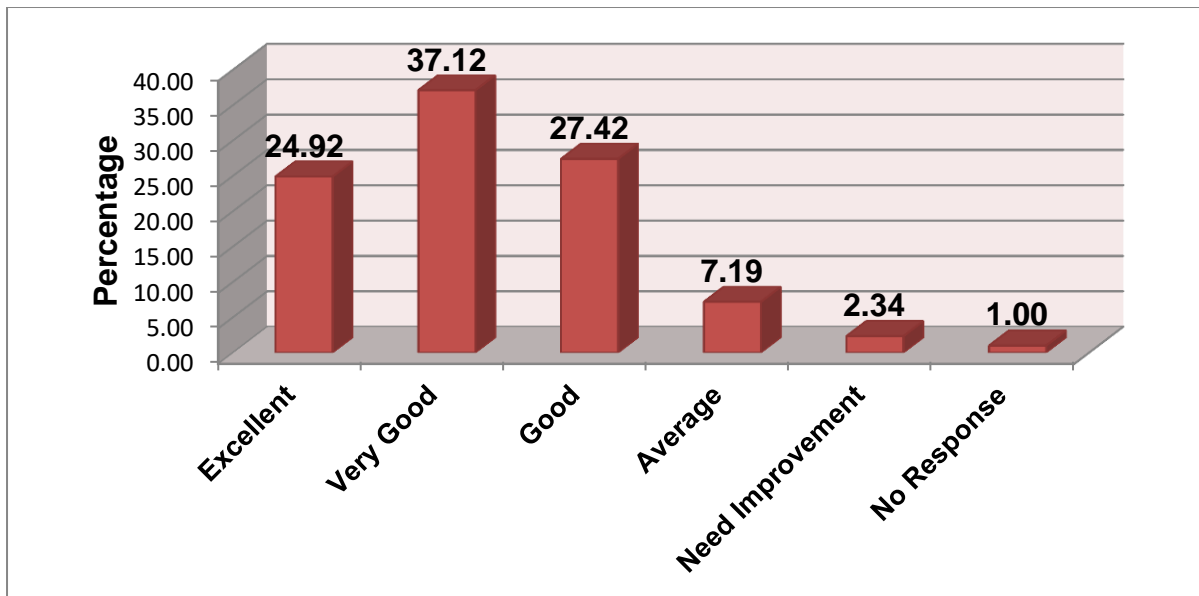

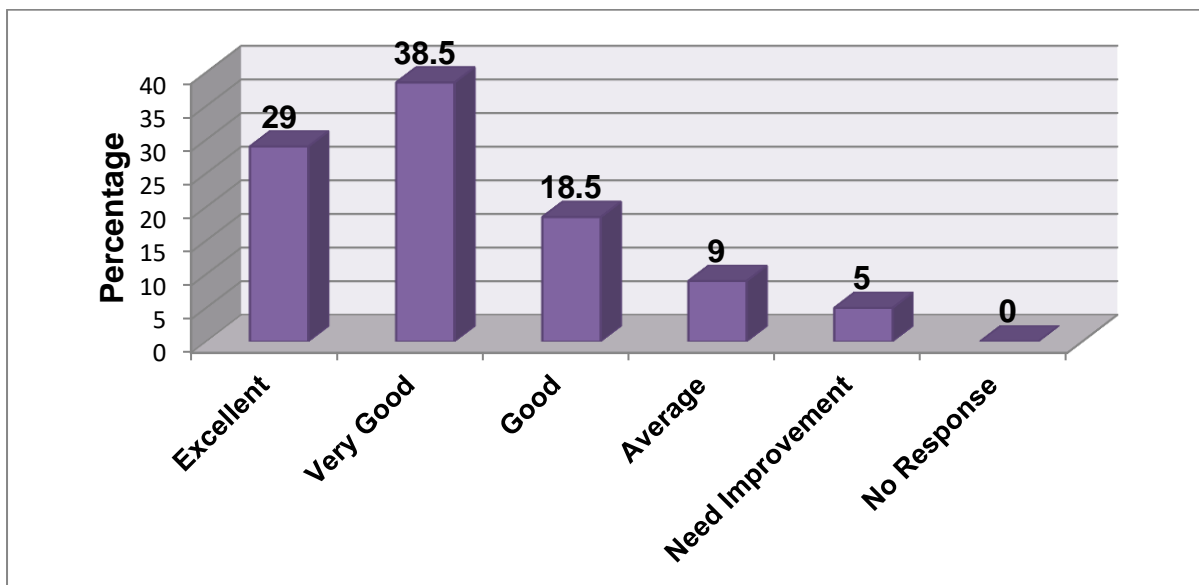

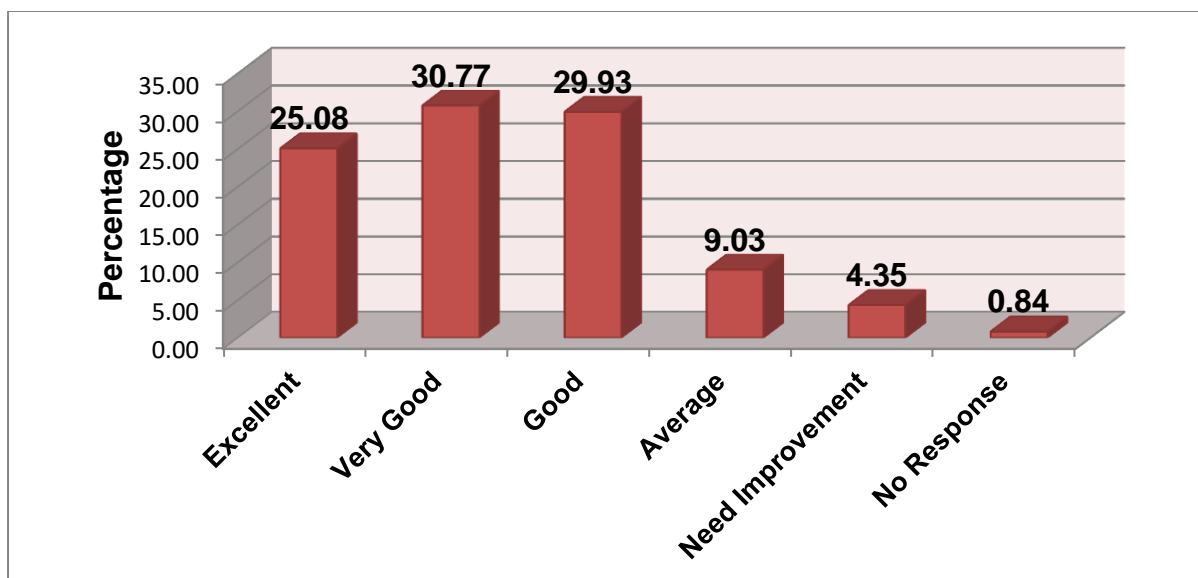

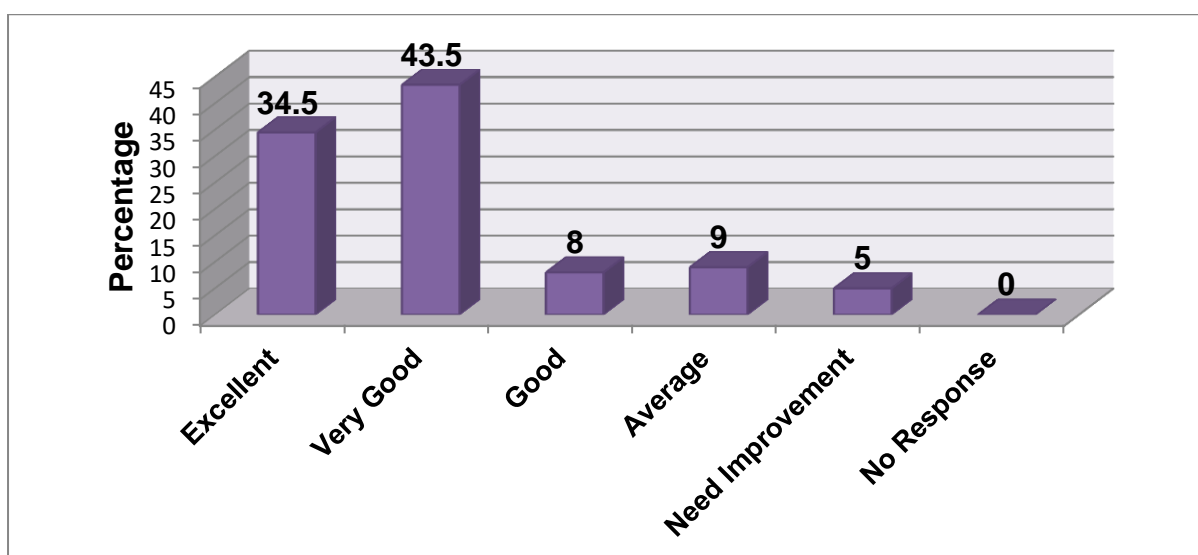

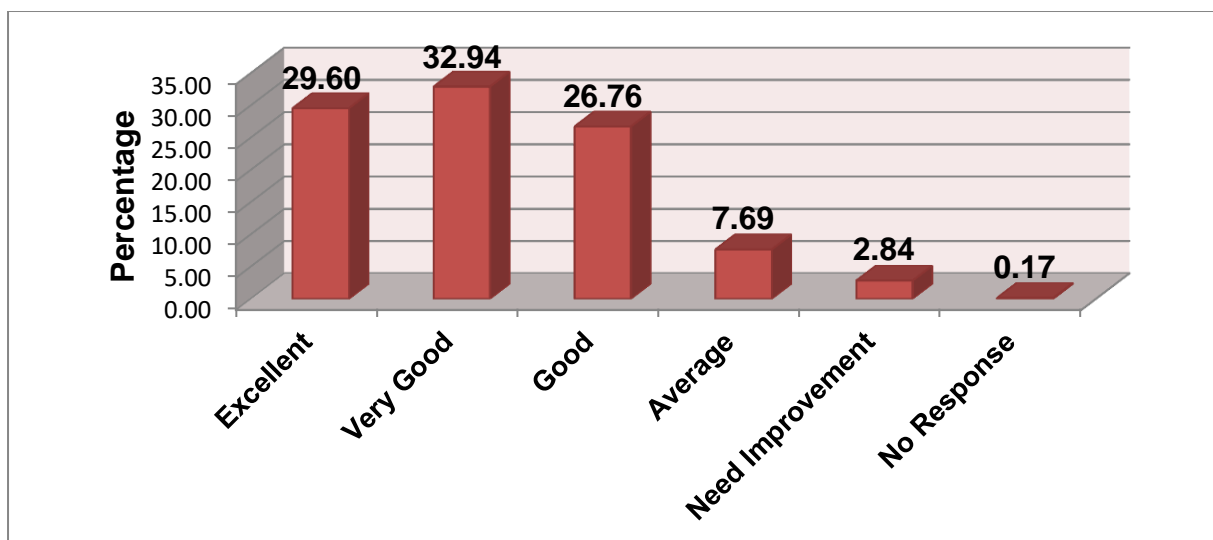

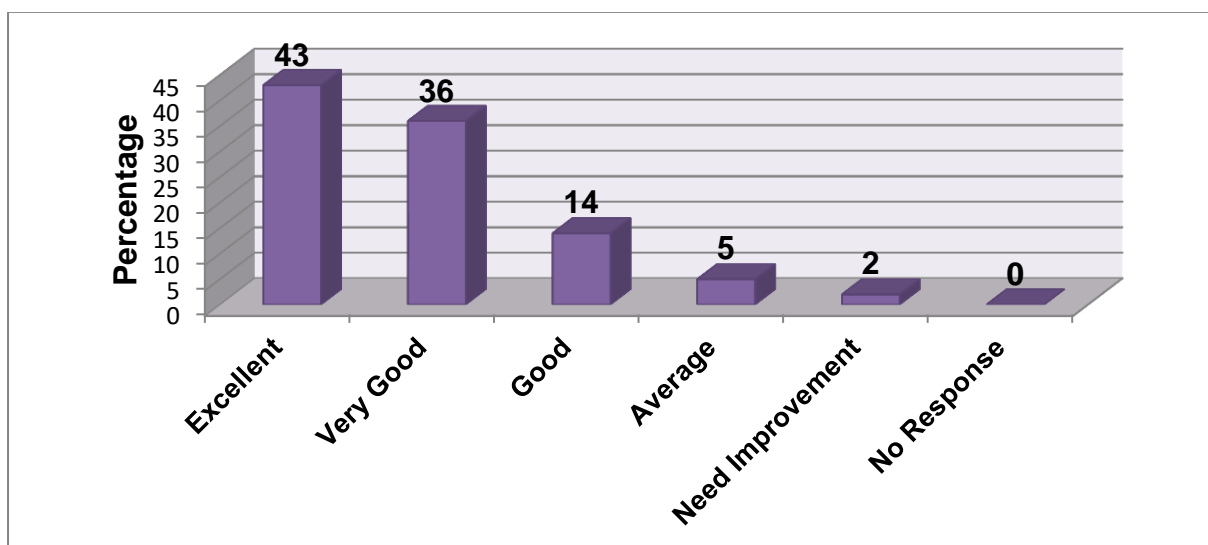

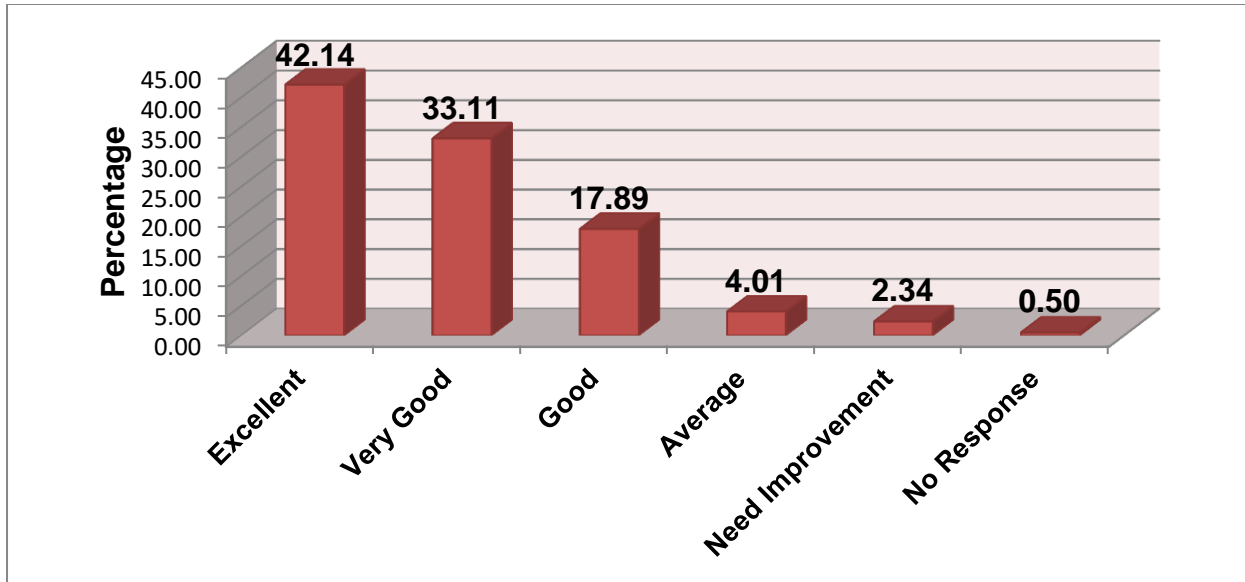

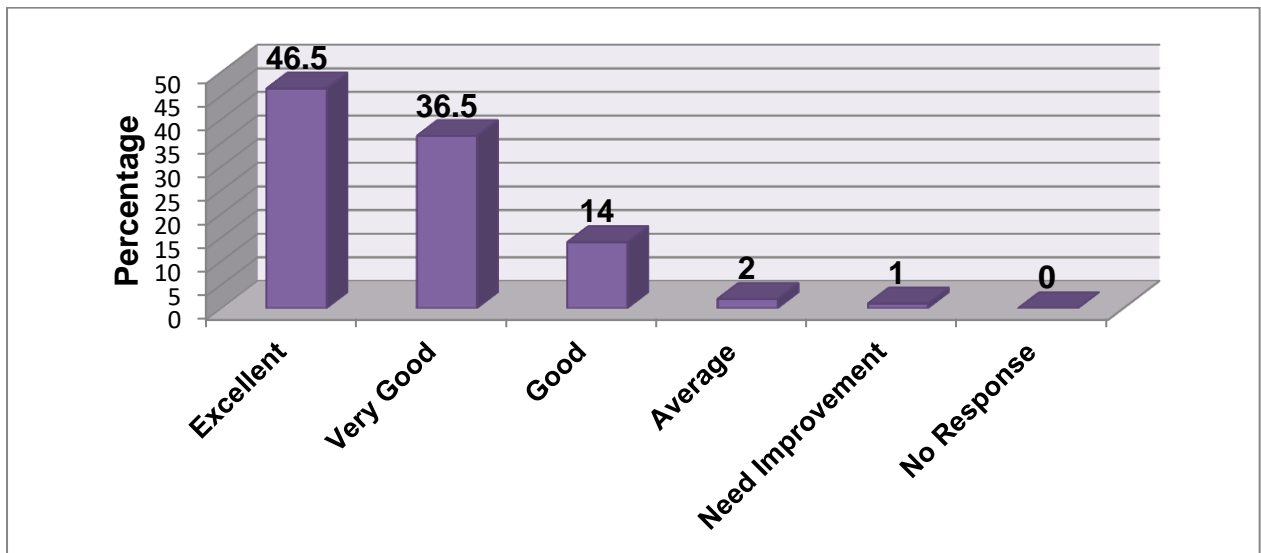

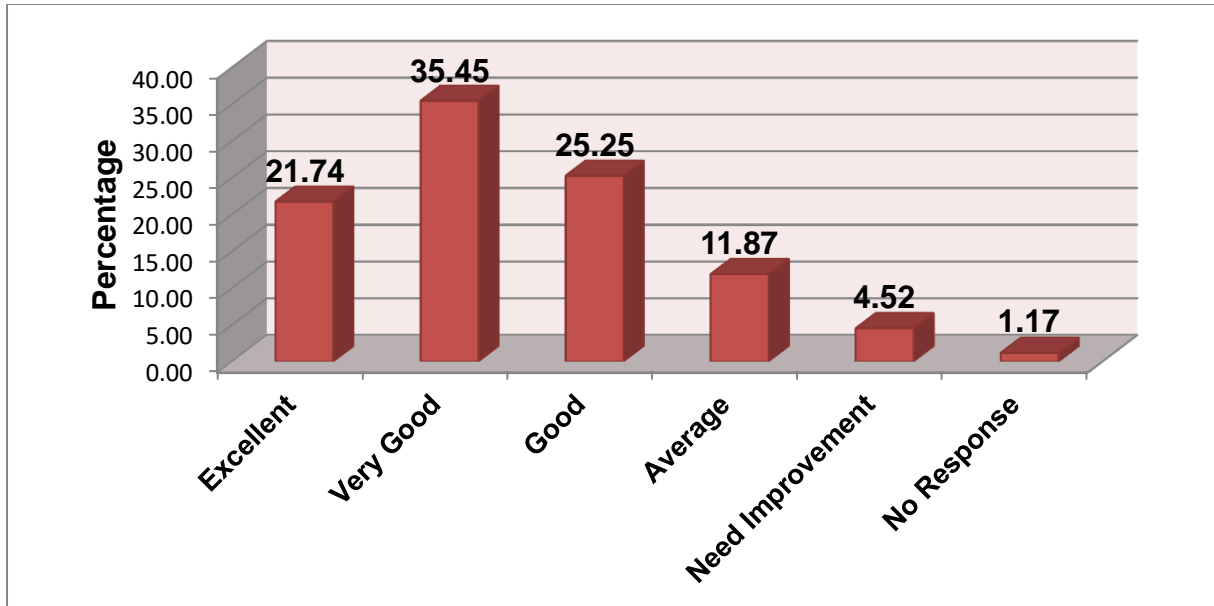

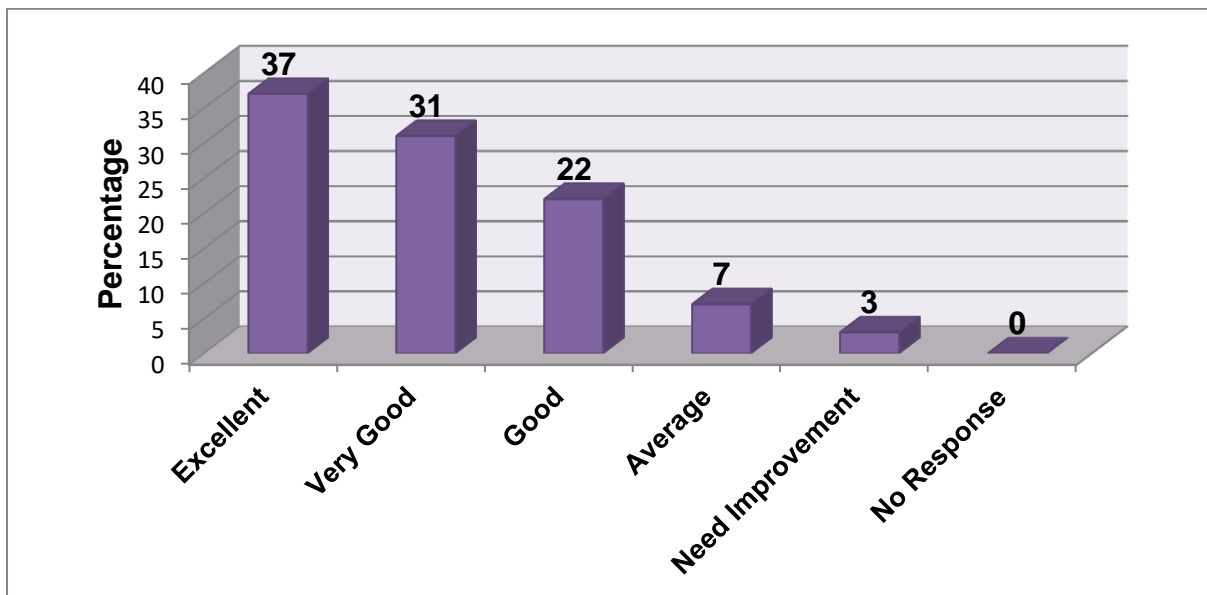

**Figure 1.9(b):-Canteen Facilities (Post Graduates)**

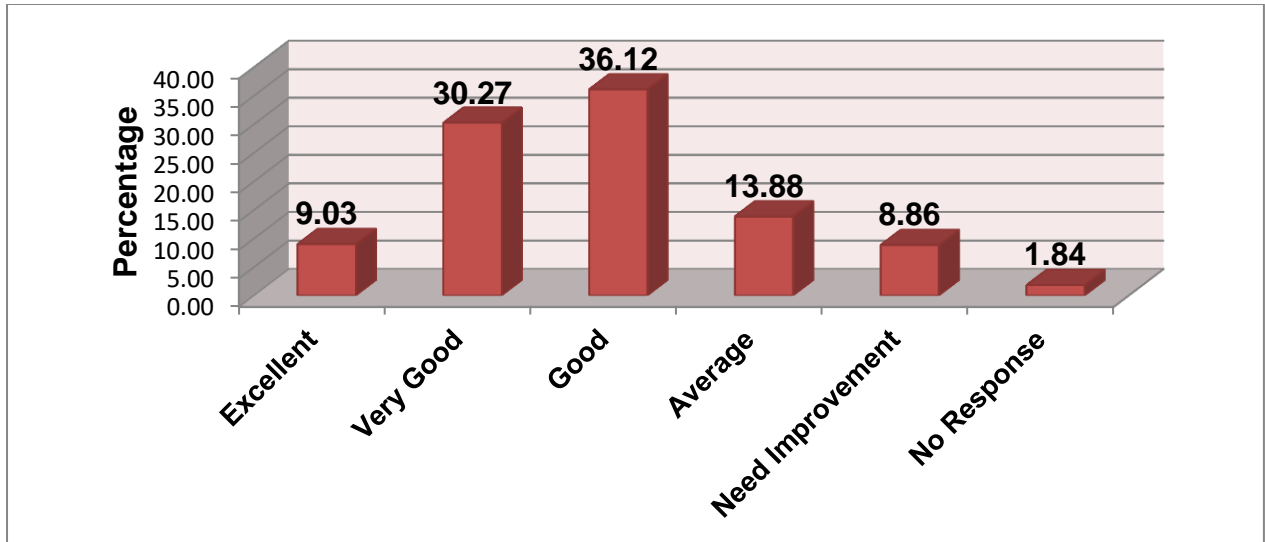

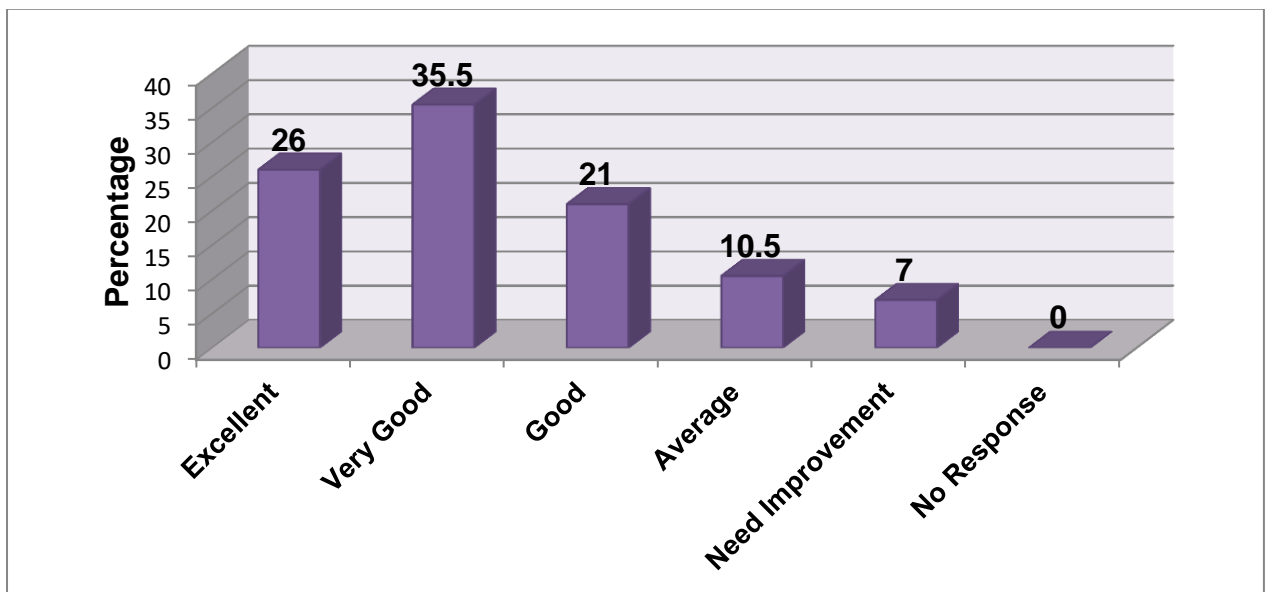

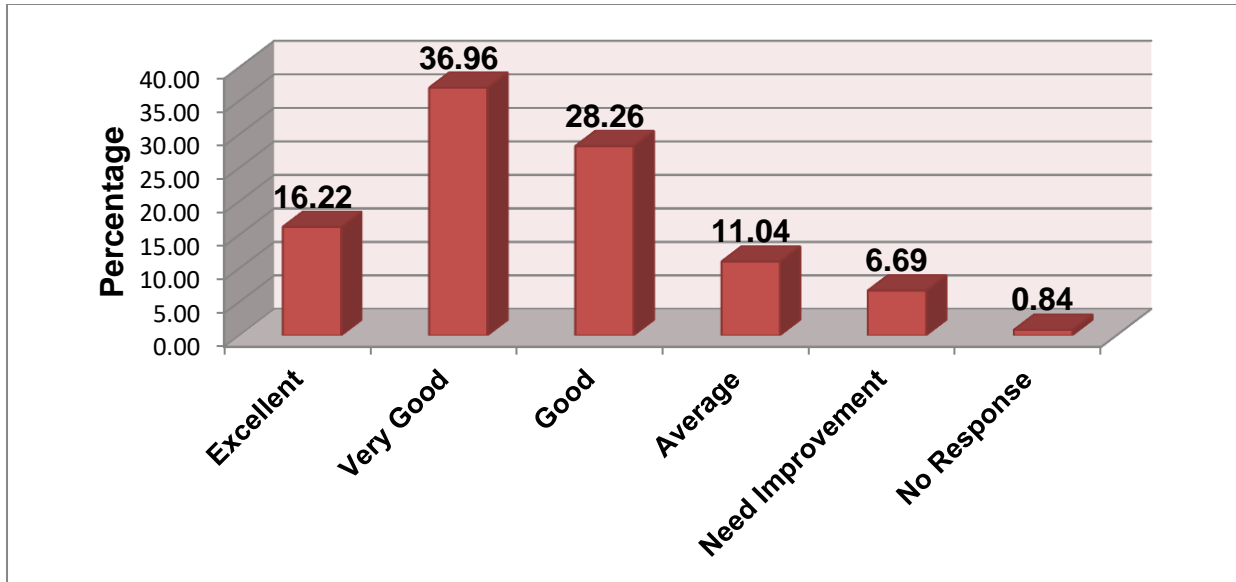

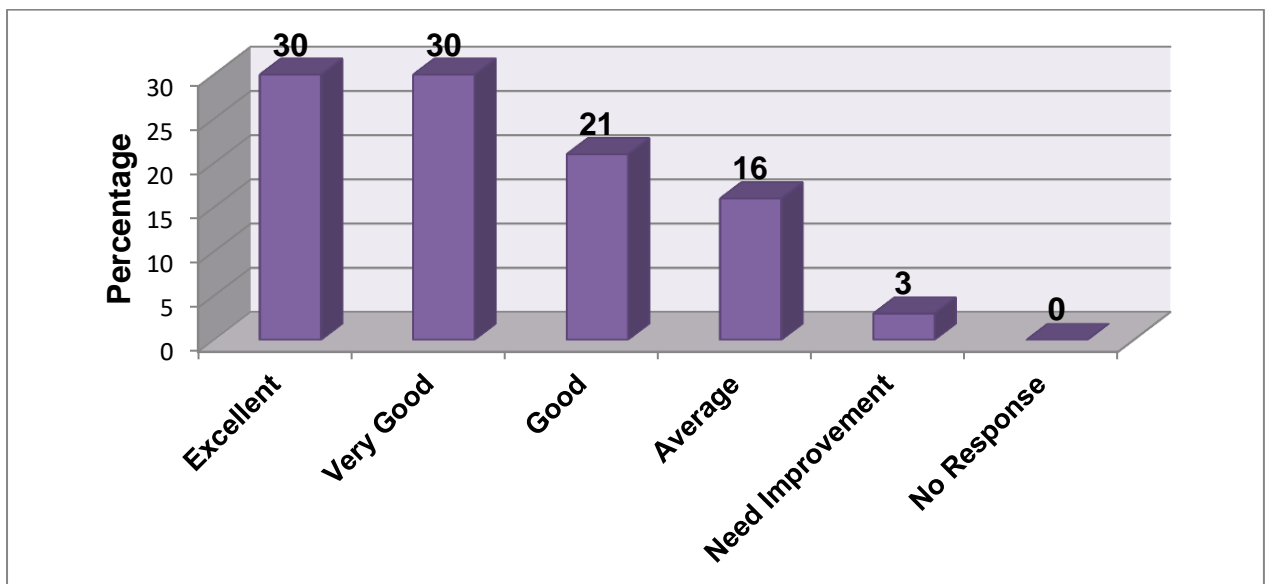

**Figure 1.11(b):-Career Counselling (Post Graduates)**

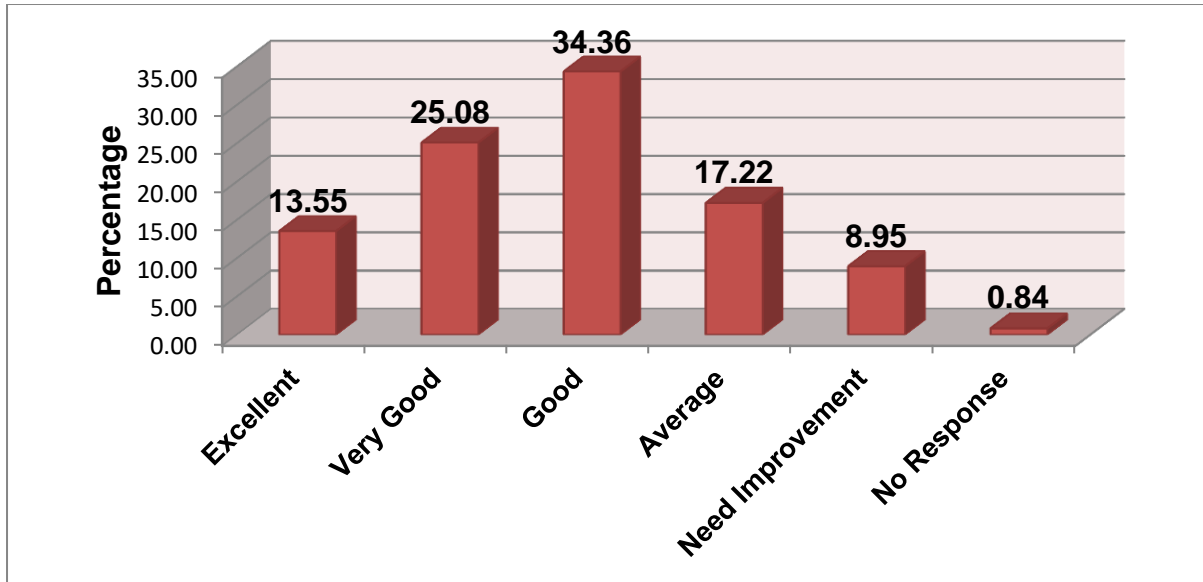

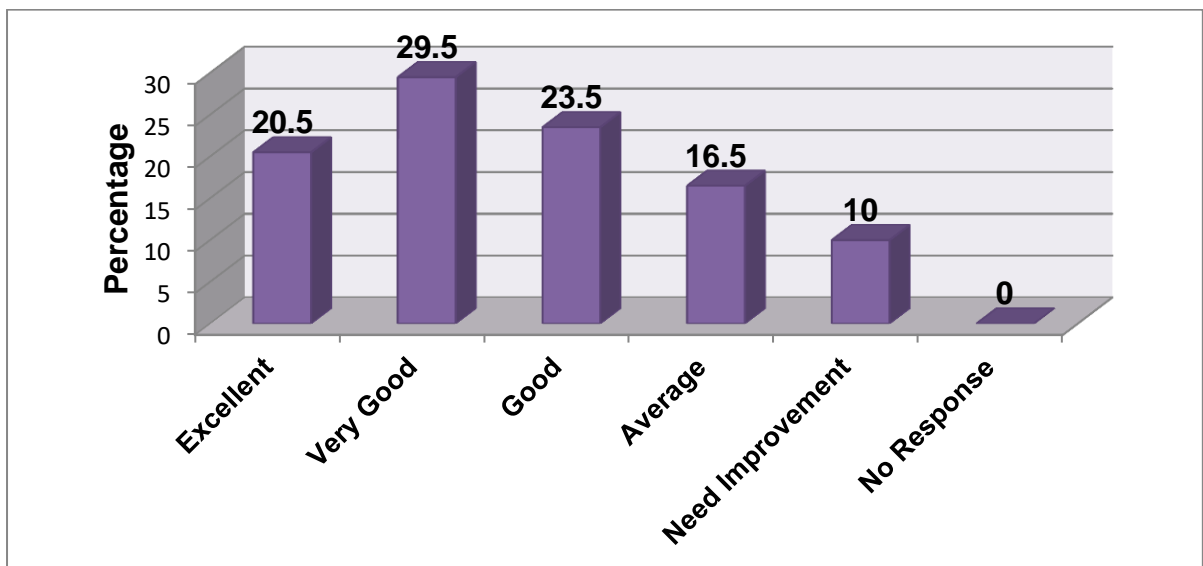

**Figure 1.12(b):-Placement Initiatives Provided (Post Graduates)**

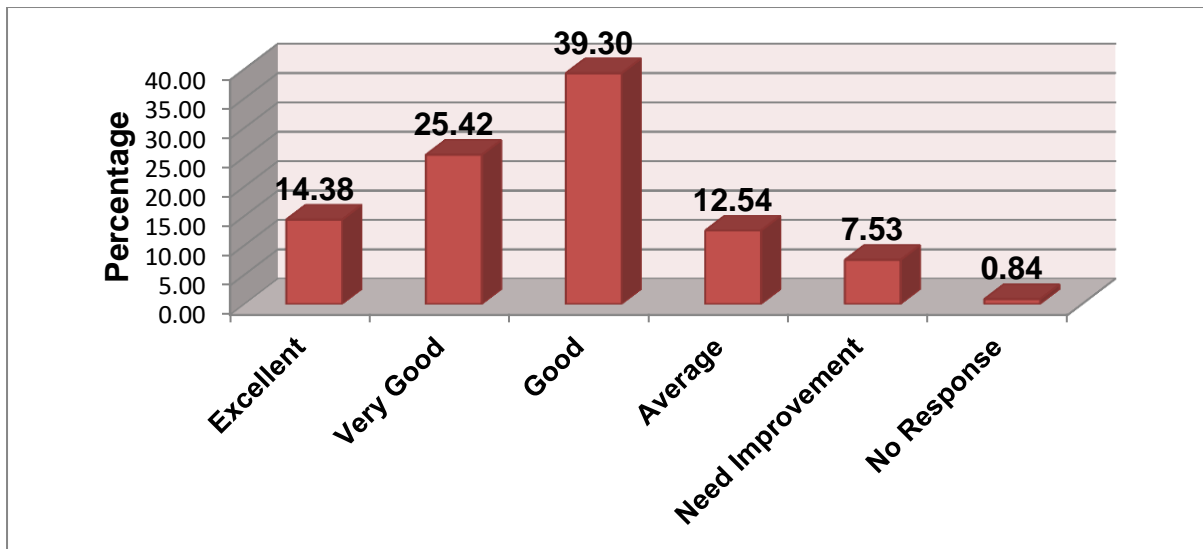

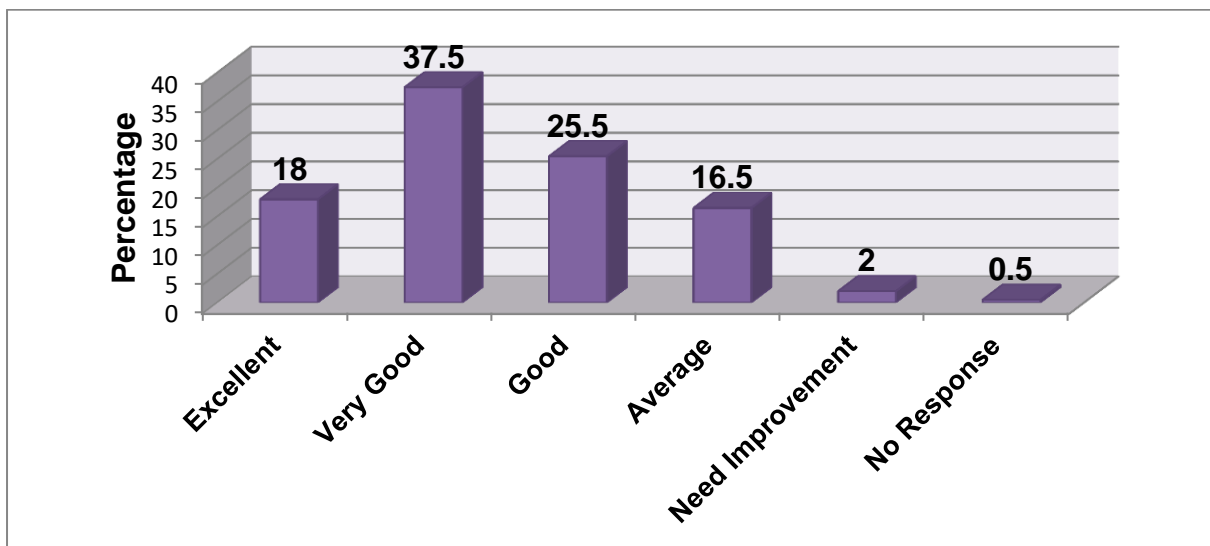

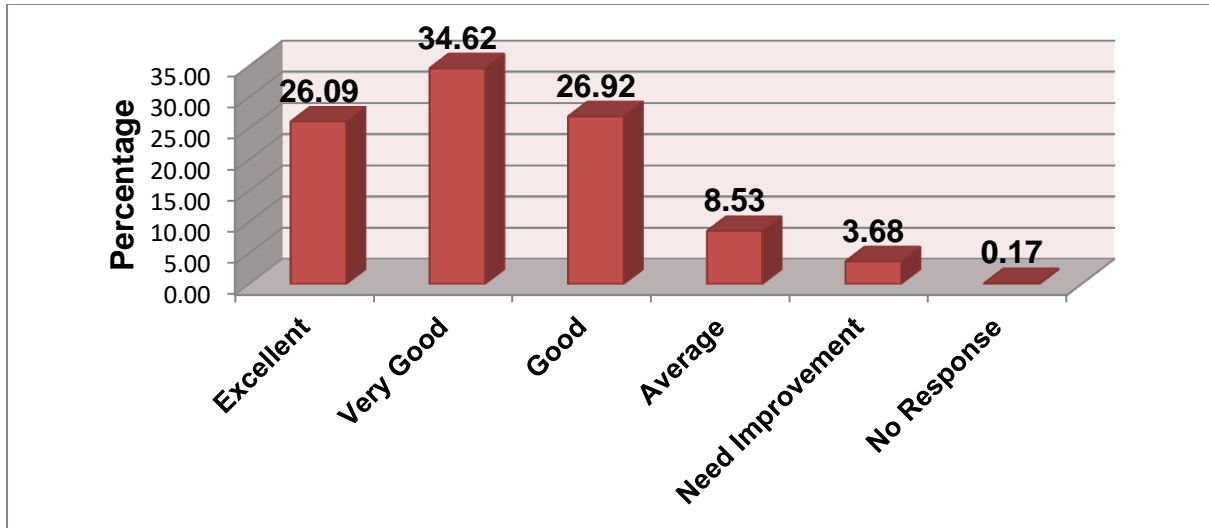

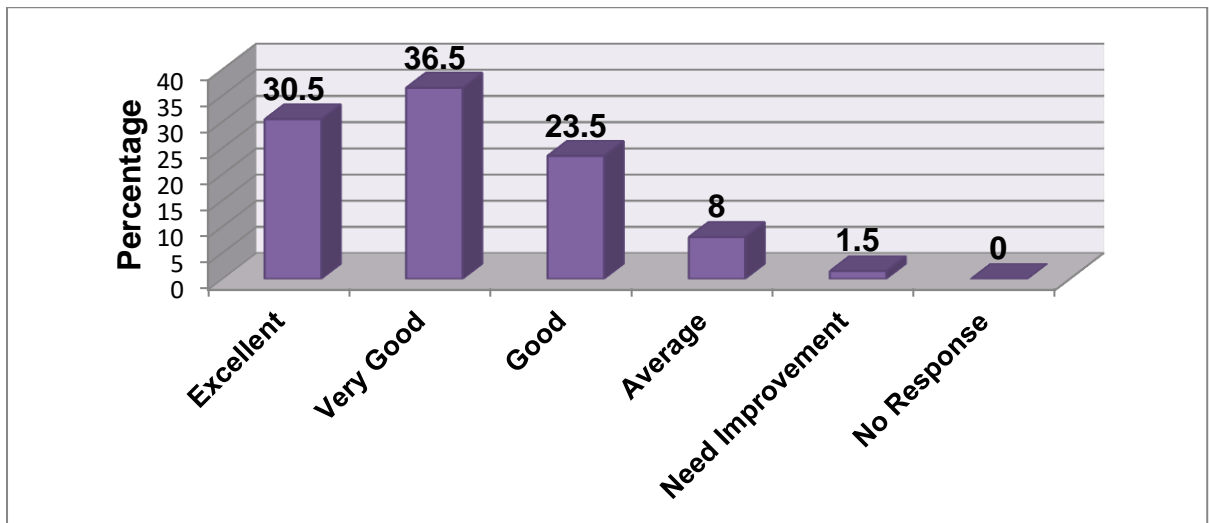

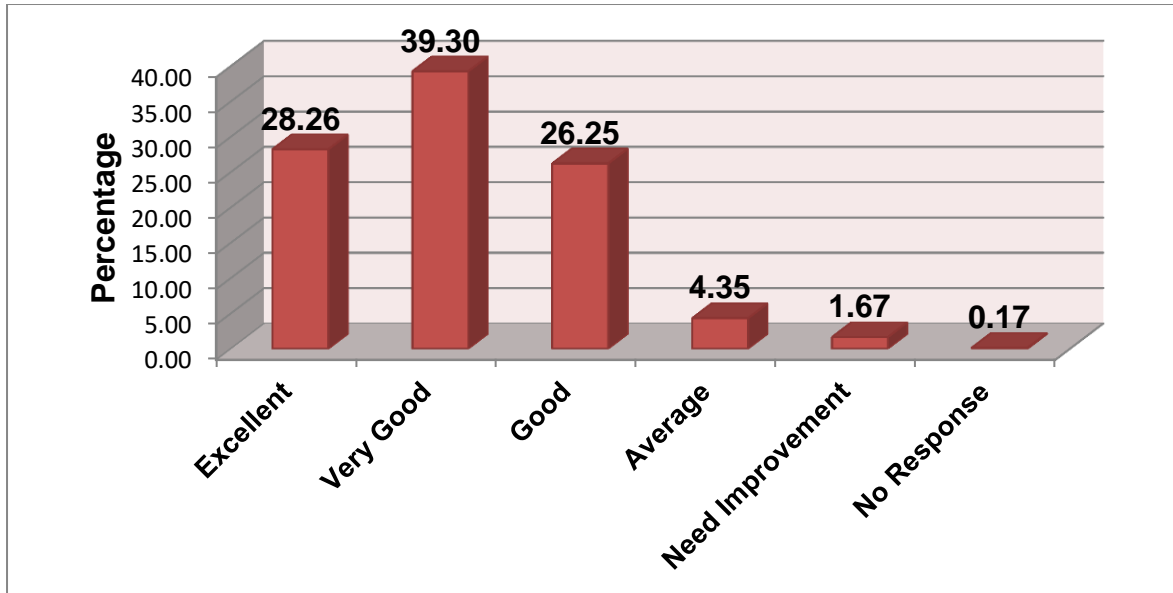

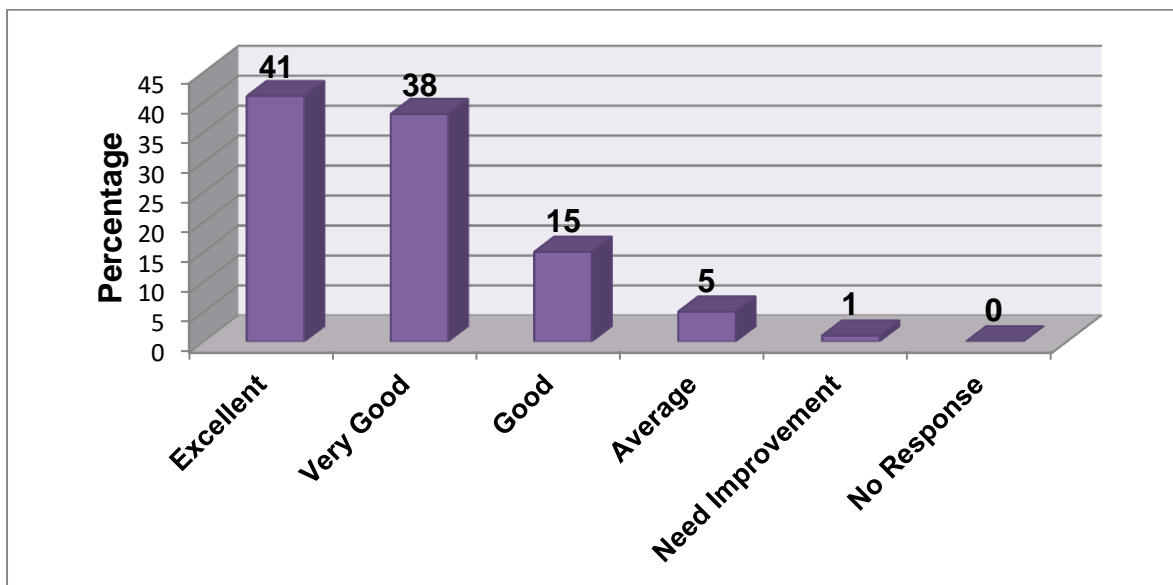

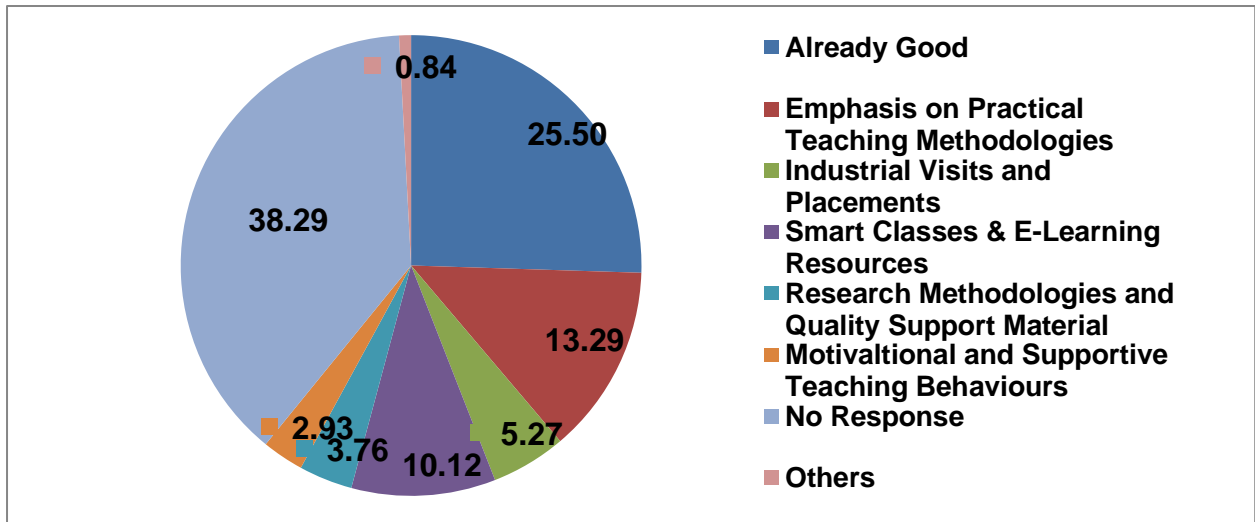
**Figure 1.15(a):-Overall Rating of the College (Graduates)**



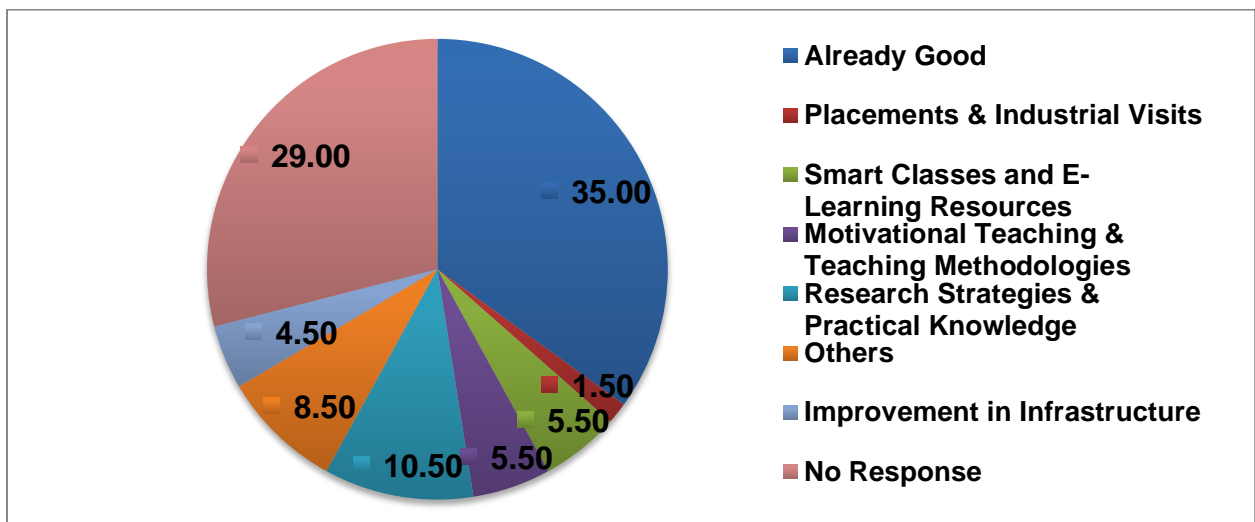
**Figure 1.15(b):-Overall Rating of the College (Post Graduates)**

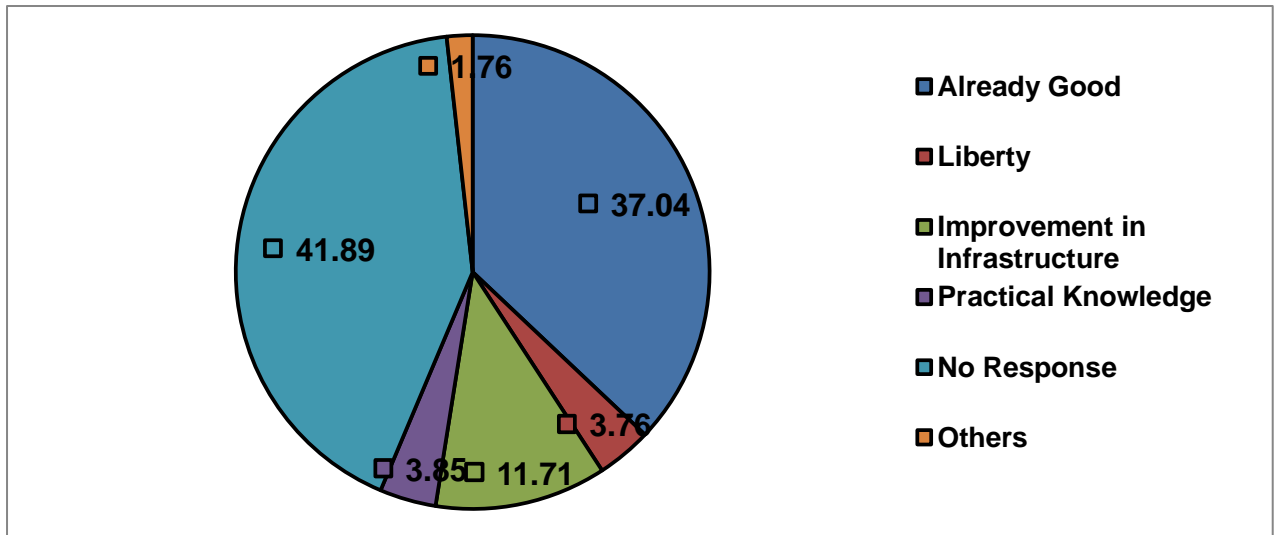
**Figure 2(a) (i).i:-Improvement in Teaching Learning Process (Graduates)**



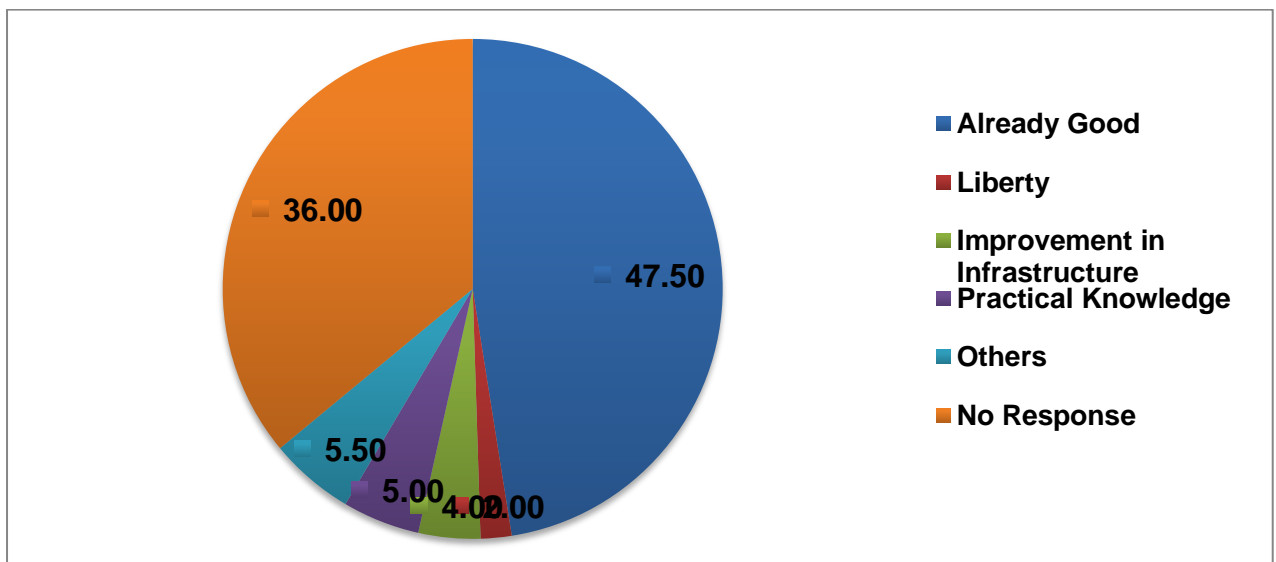
**Figure 2a (i).ii:-Improvement in Teaching Learning Process (Post Graduates)**

As far as teaching and learning process of the institution is concerned, 25.5% of graduates and 35% of post graduates alumnae have stated that it is already very good whereas others have given their suggestions regarding improvement which are always welcomed by the college and that the college tries to work upon. 13.29% of graduate alumnae and 10.50% Of post graduate alumnae says that more emphasis should be laid on practical work and research work, there is a need to provide more smart classrooms and E-learning resources to students say 10.12%, 5.50% of graduate and post graduate alumni, 5.27% of graduate and 1.50% of post graduate alumnae feel that college should organize more industrial visits and campus placements, teaching methodologies should be more motivational and supportive is the suggestion given by 2.93% of graduate and 5.50% of post graduate alumnae.

**2a (ii) OVERALL IMPROVEMENT IN COLLEGE ENVIRONMENT**



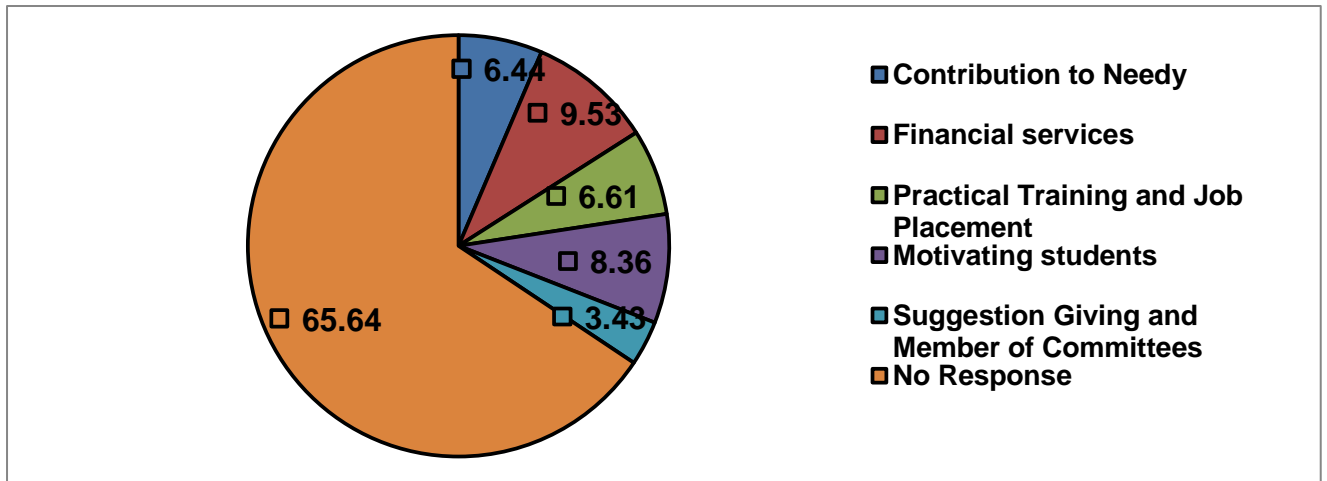
**Figure 2a (ii).i:-Overall Improvement in College Environment (Graduates)**



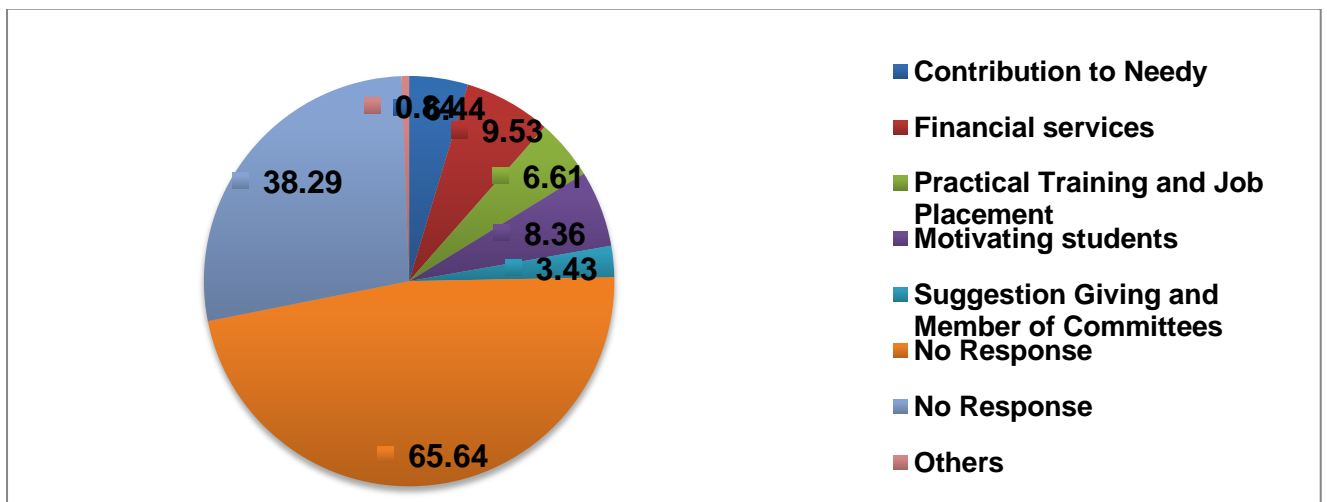
**Figure 2a (ii).ii:-Overall Improvement in College Environment (Post Graduates)**

The data analysis shows that 37.40% of graduate and 47.50% of post graduate alumnae find college environment already good whereas remaining have indicated some improvement in different fields. 11.71% of graduate and 4.00% of post graduate respondents want infrastructure to be improved. 3.85% of graduate and 5.00% of post graduate alumnae feel that more emphasis should be laid on imparting practical knowledge. 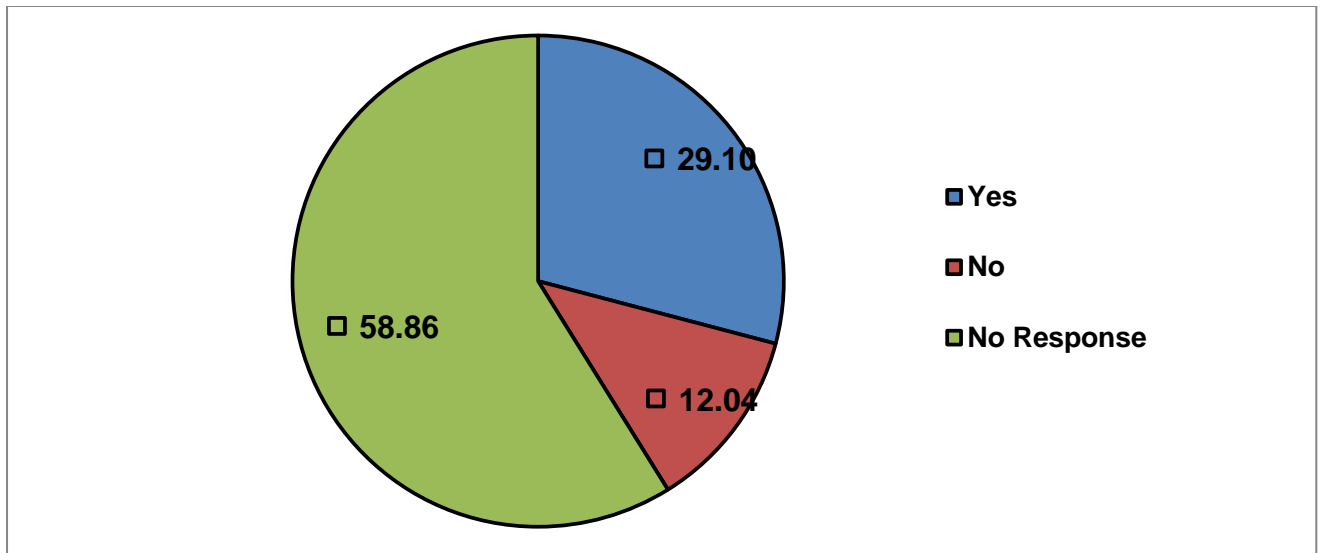
**Figure 2(b).i:-Contribution for the Betterment (Graduates)**



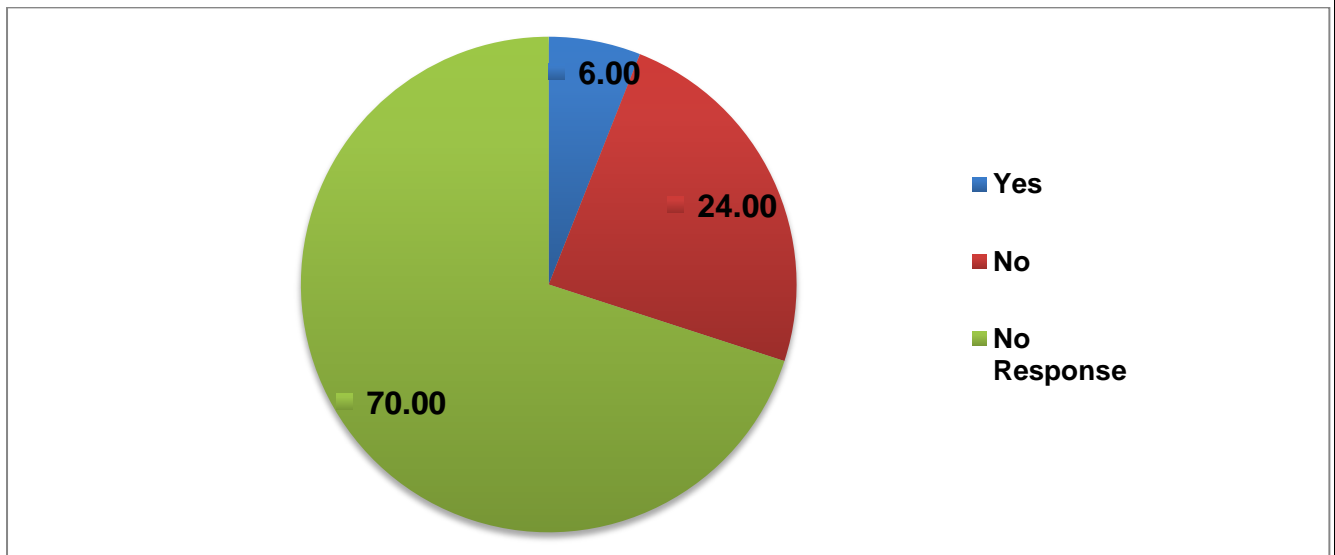
**Figure 2(b).ii:-Contribution for the Betterment (Post Graduates)**

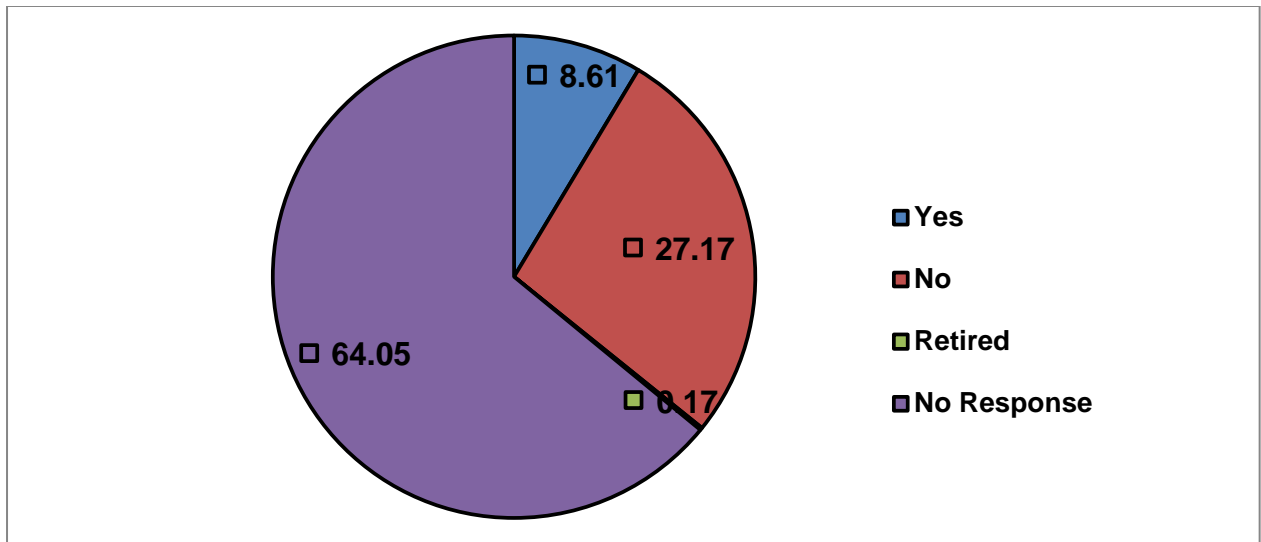
**Figure 3(a):-Degree after completing studies from HMV (Graduates)**



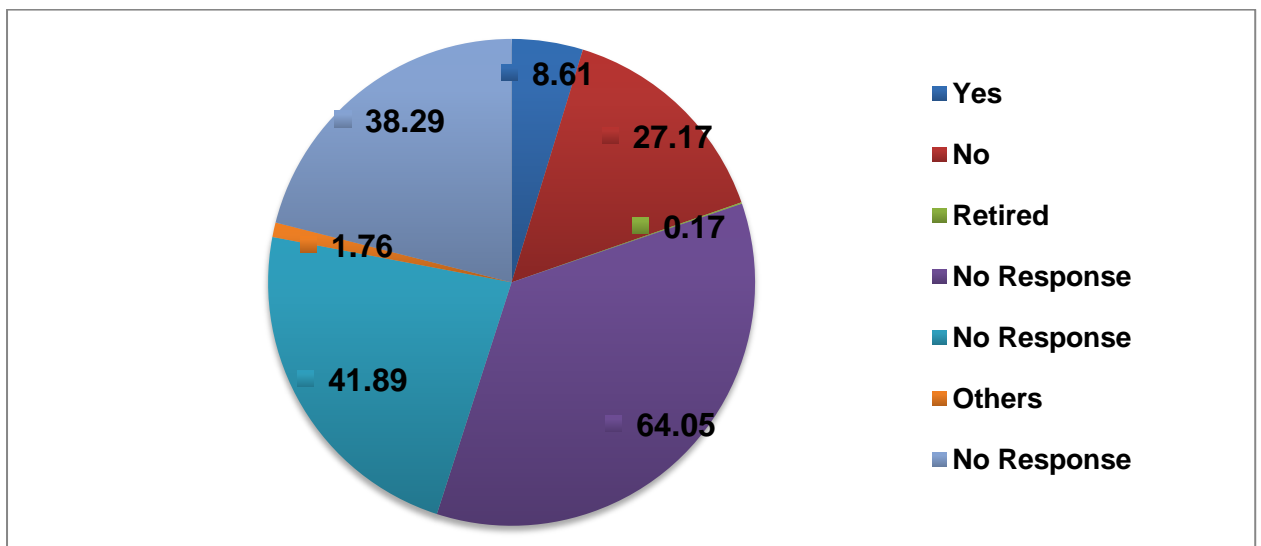
**Figure 3(b):-Degree after completing studies from HMV (Post Graduates)**

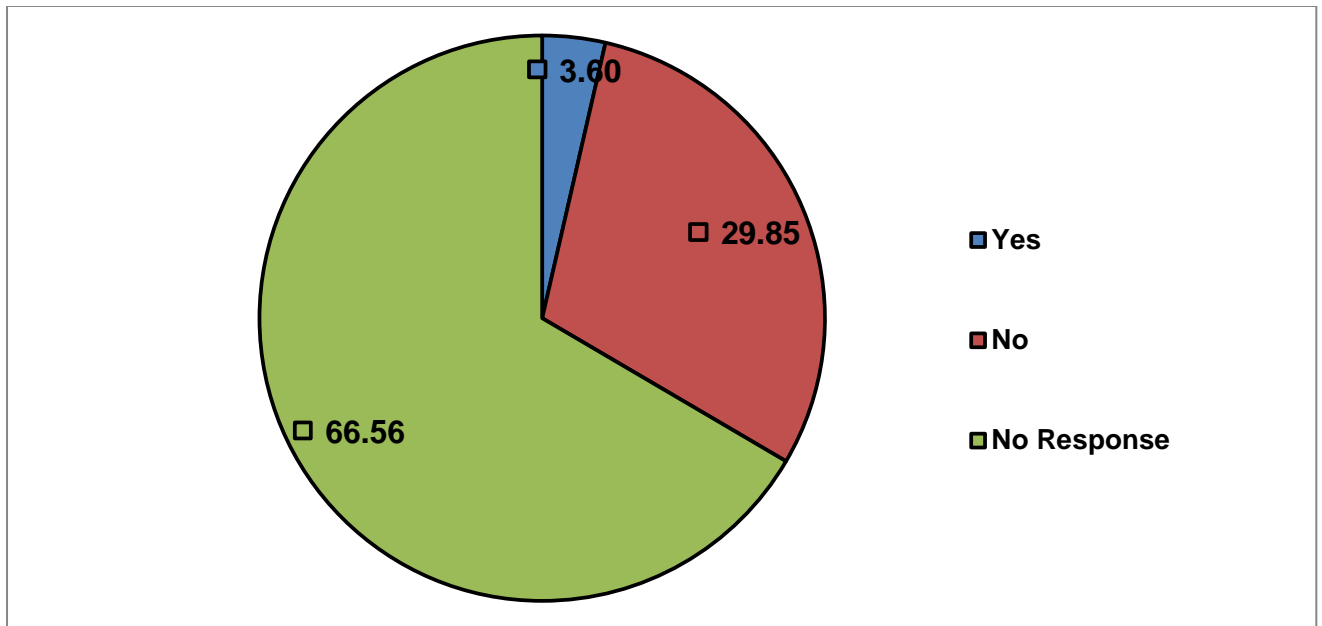
**Figure 4(a):-Currently Employed (Graduates)**



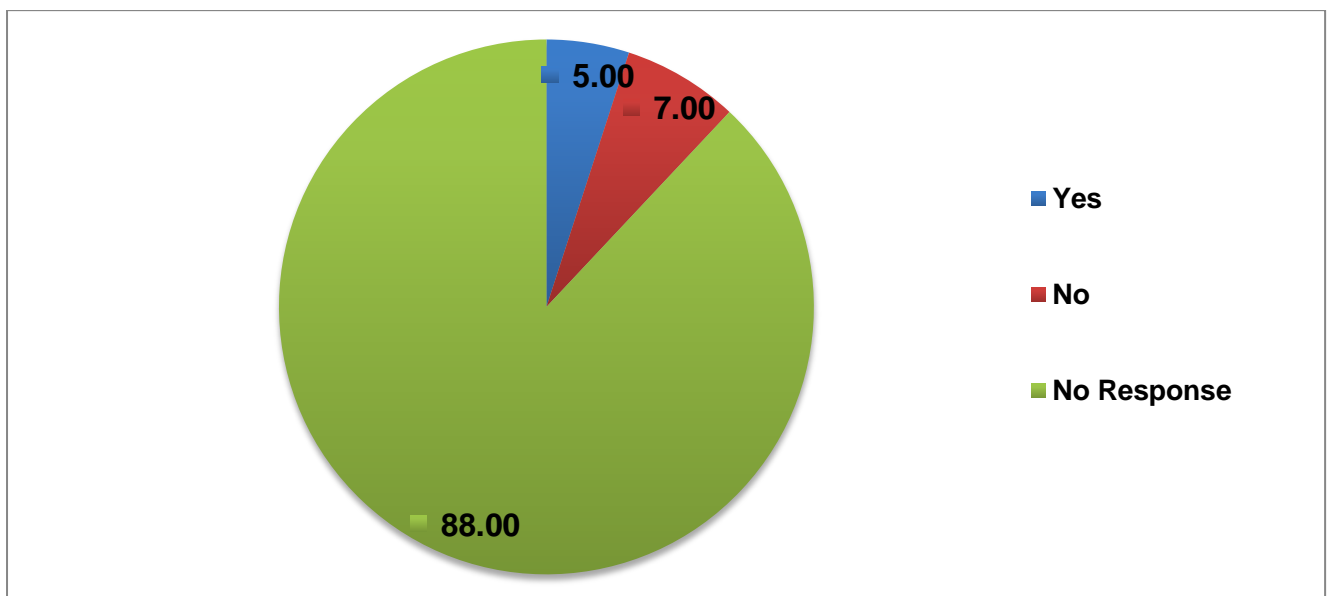
**Figure 4(b):-Currently Employed (Post Graduates)**

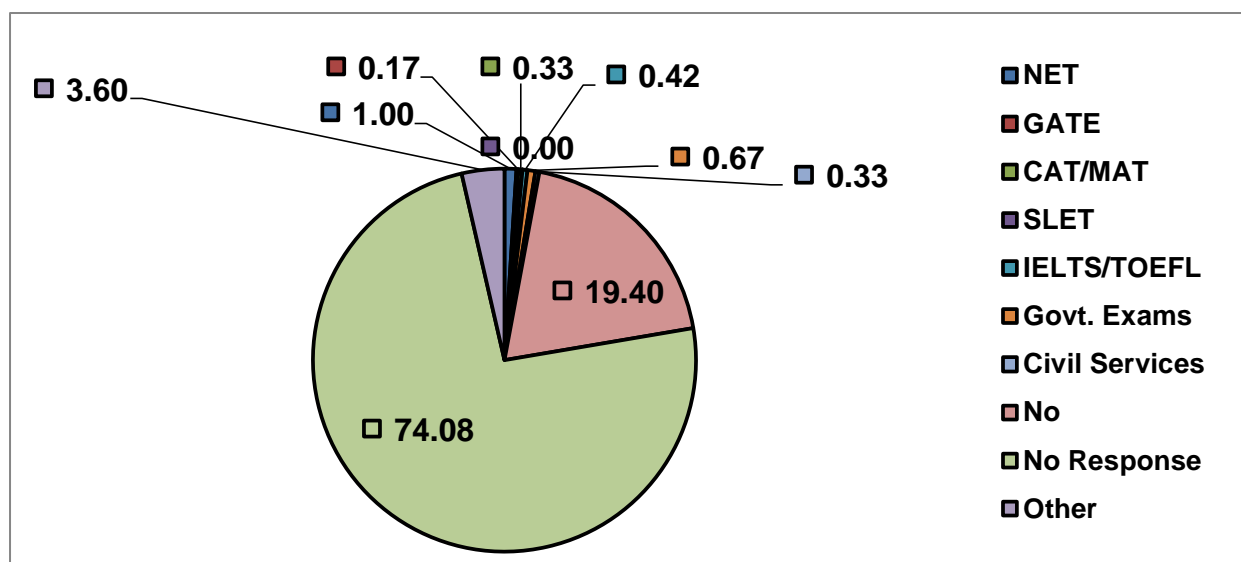
**Figure 5(a):-Self Employed (Graduates)**



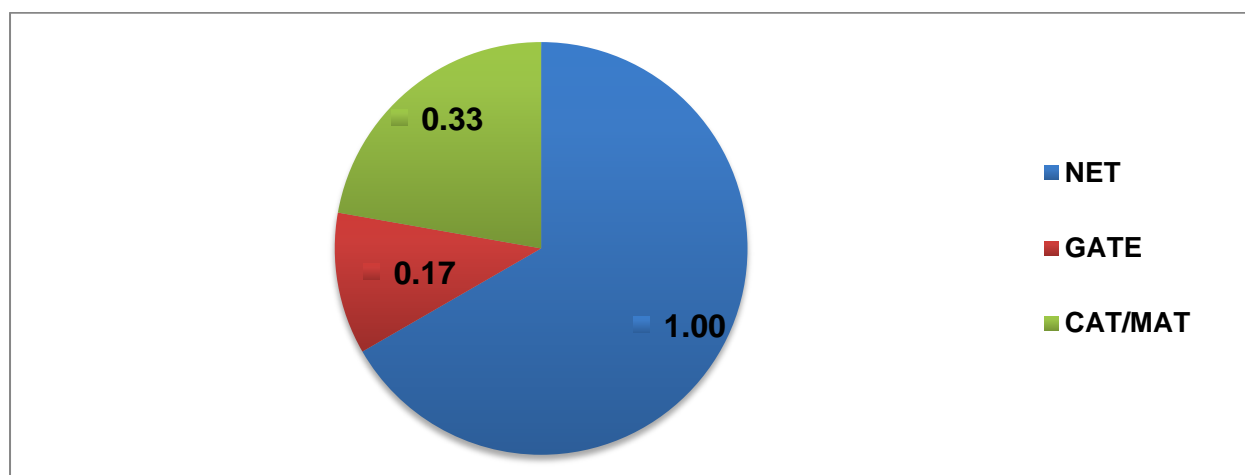
**Figure 5(b):-Self Employed (Post Graduates)**

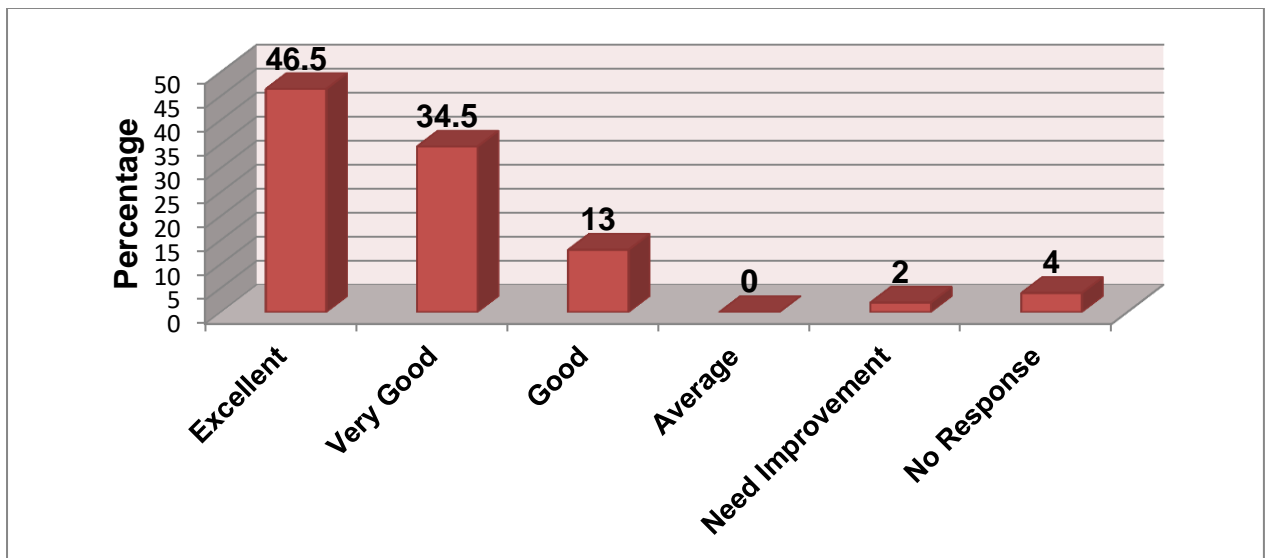


Figure 7.1(a):-Enhanced Knowledge (Graduates)

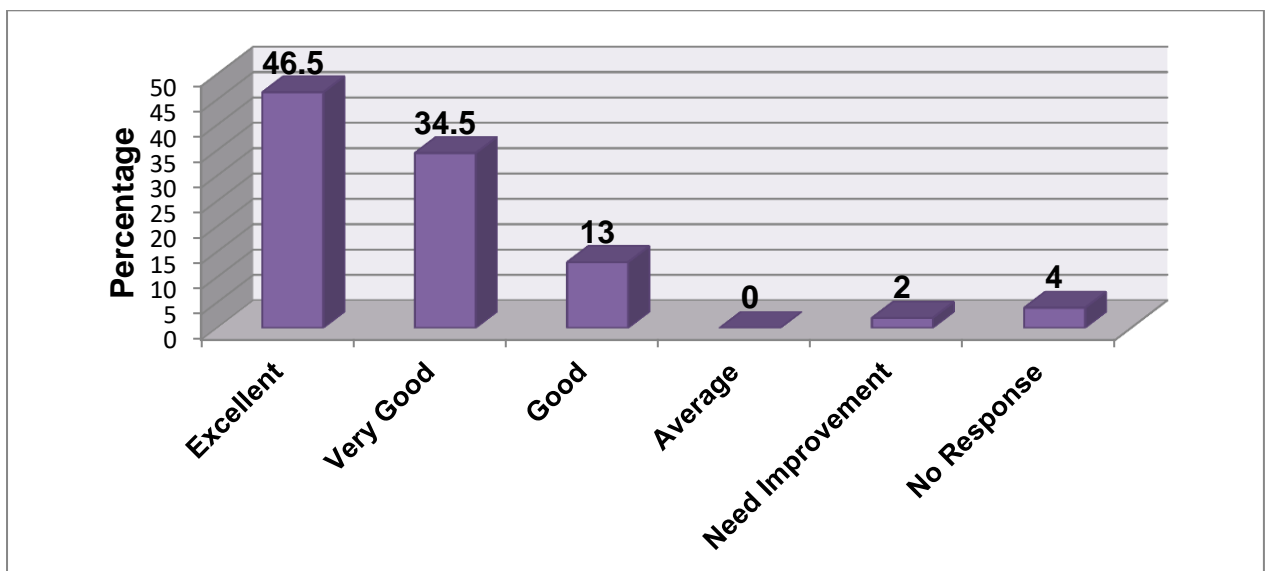


Figure 7.1(b):-Enhanced Knowledge (Post Graduates)

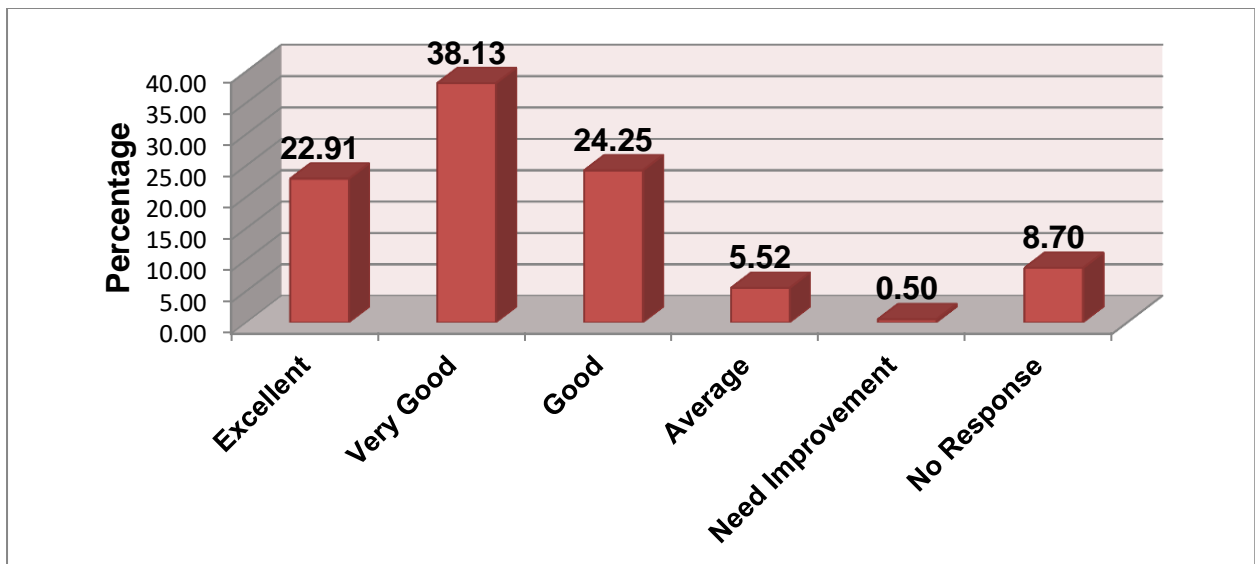


Figure 7.2(a):-Enhanced Skills (Graduates)

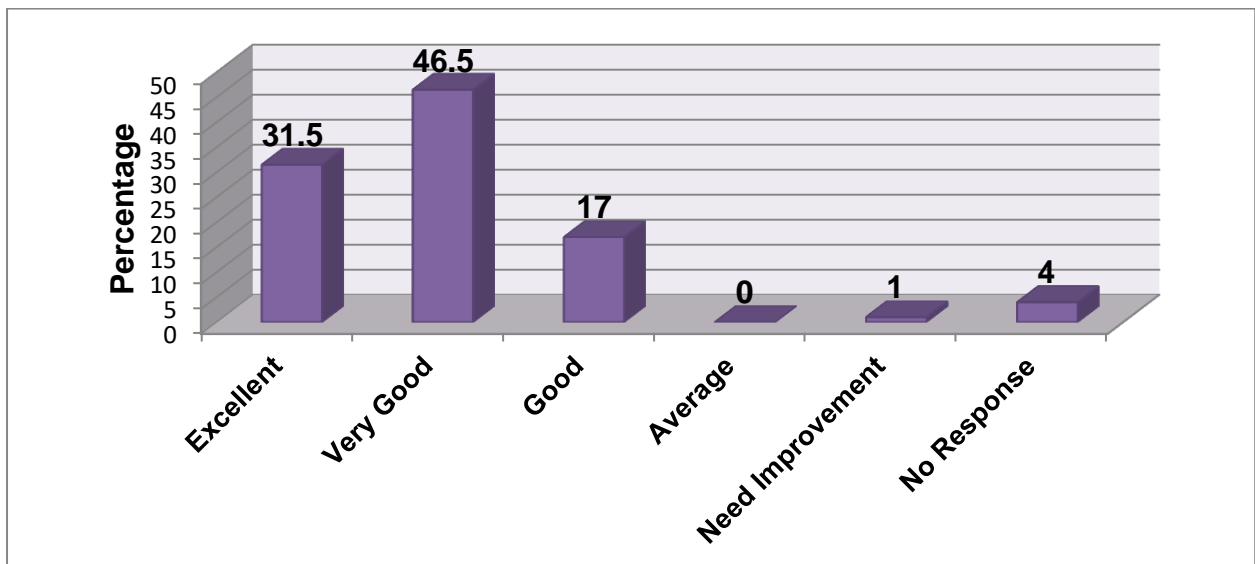
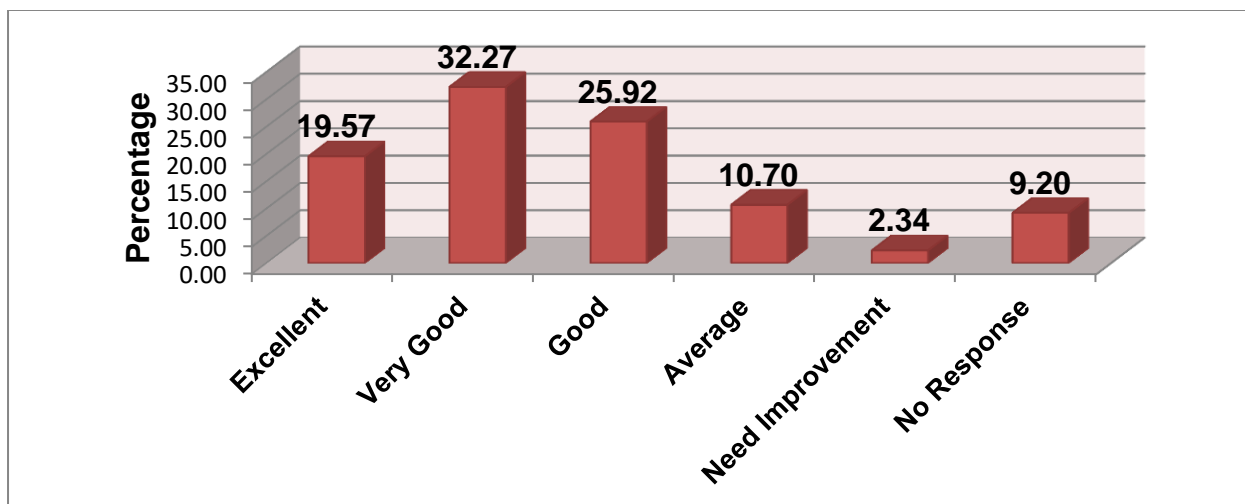


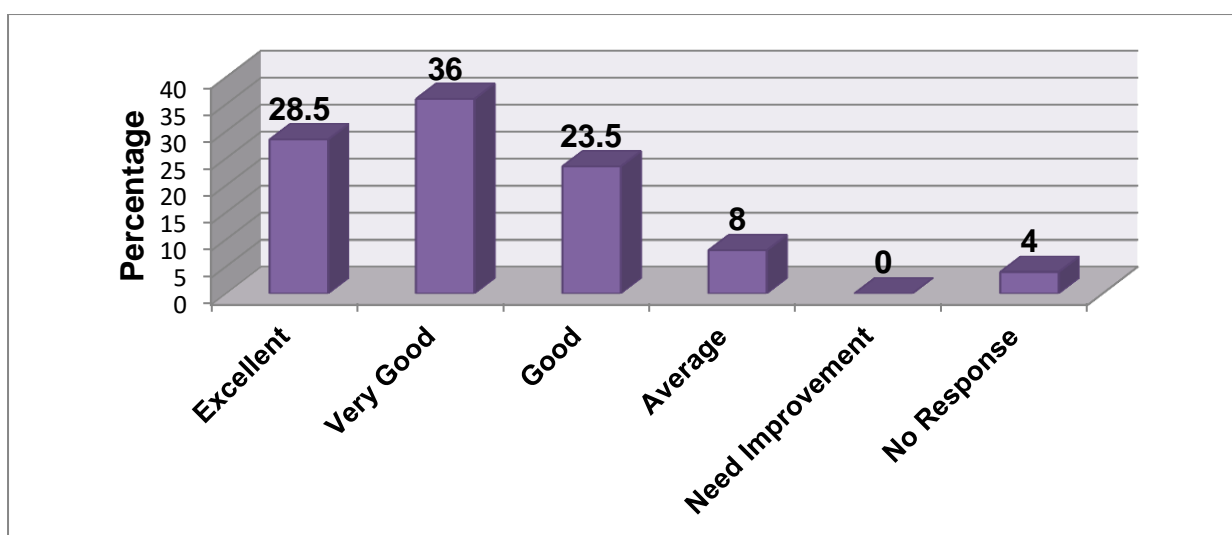
Figure 7.2(b):-Enhanced Skills (Post Graduates)

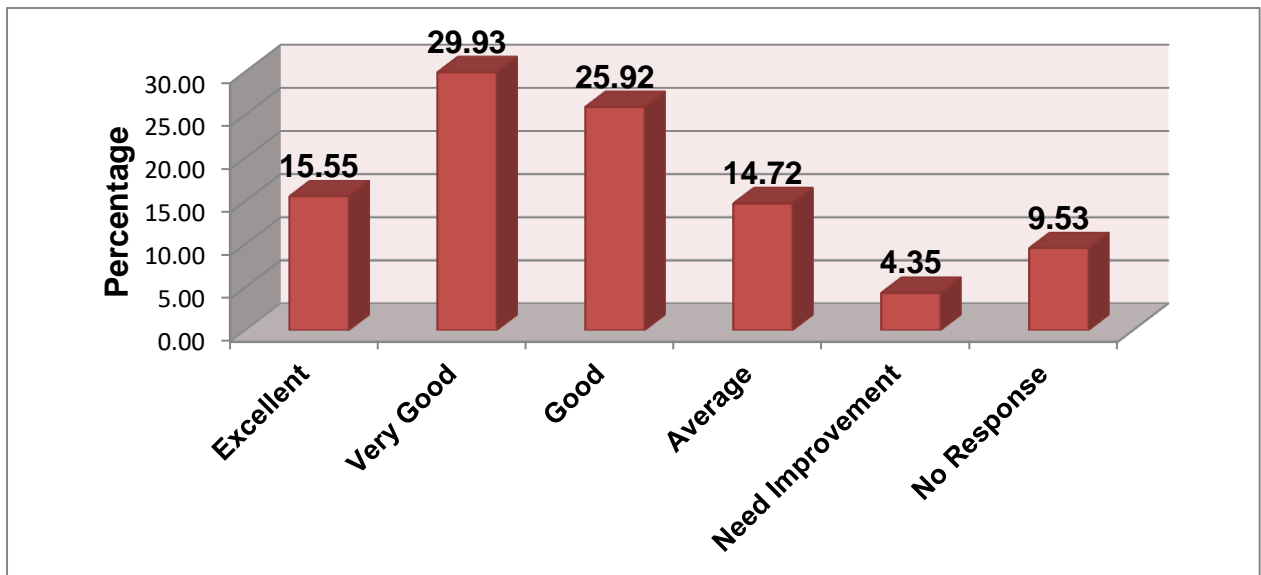


Figure 7.4(a):-Enhanced Research Aptitude (Graduates)

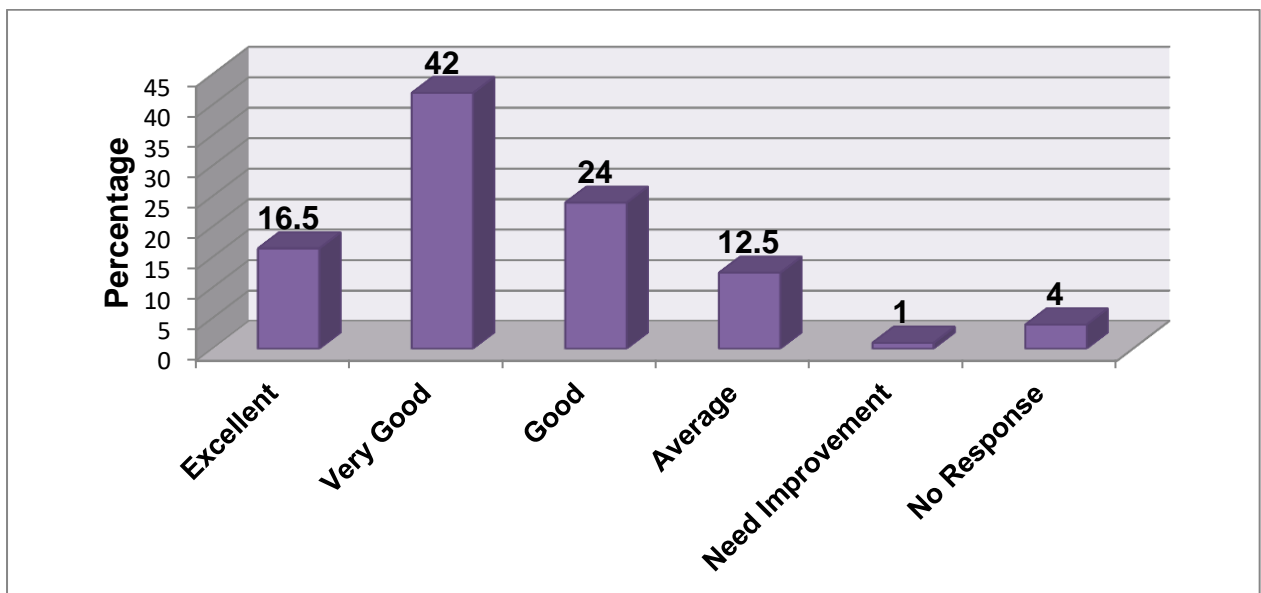


Figure 7.4(b):-Enhanced Research Aptitude (Post Graduates)

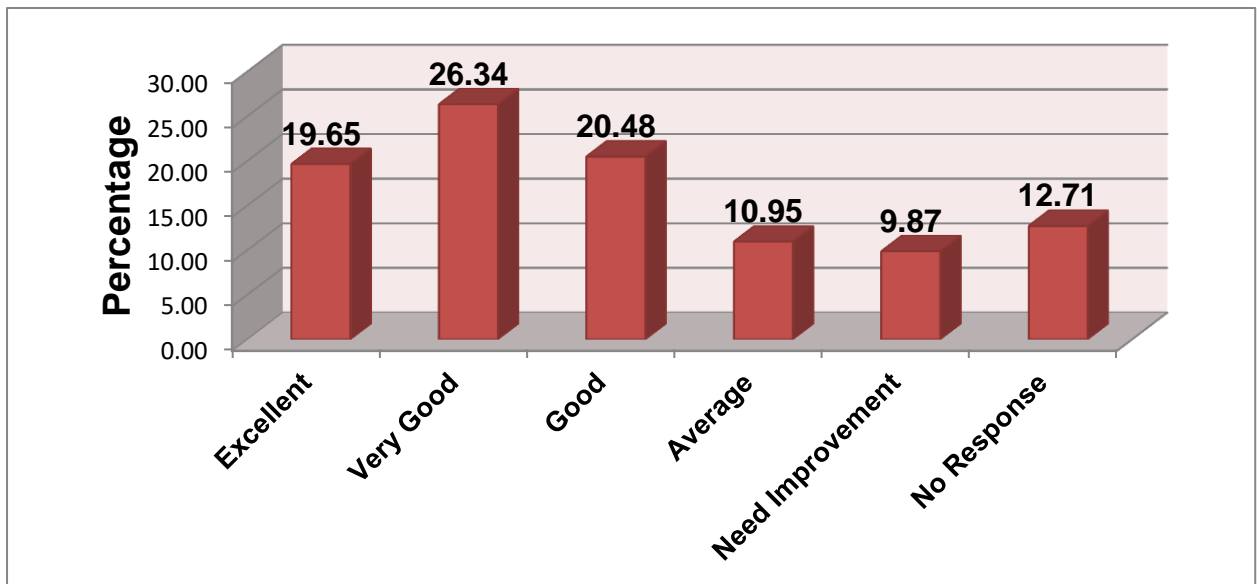


Figure 7.5(a):-Enhanced Jobs Orientation (Graduates)

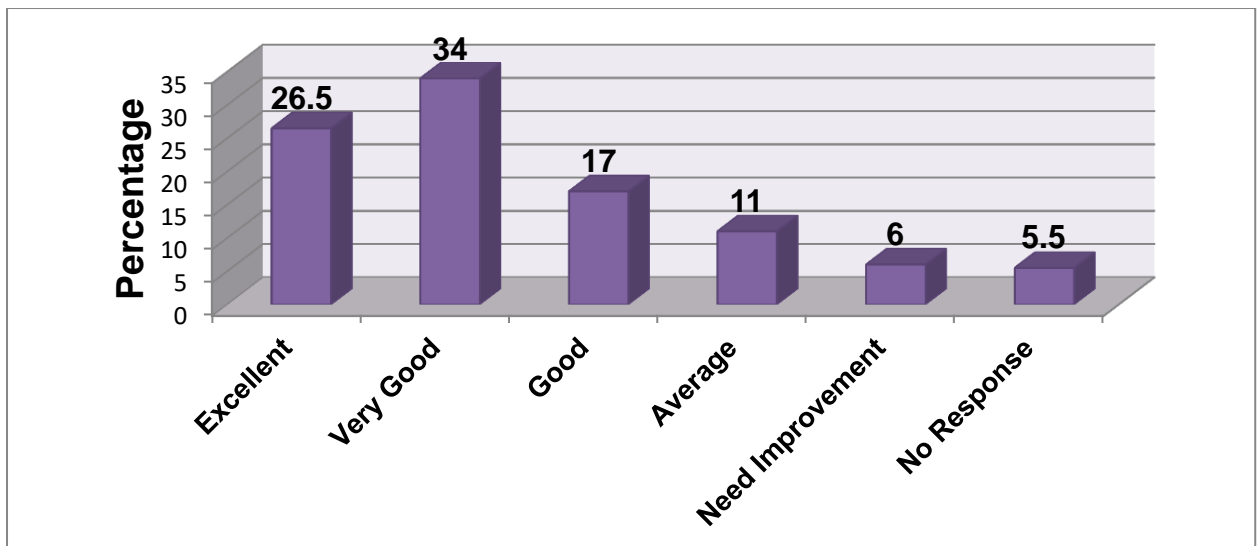


Figure 7.5(b):-Enhanced Jobs Orientation (Post Graduates)
